## AN ACT

- Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
  Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, providing for
  character of discharge.

  The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
  hereby enacts as follows:

  Section 1. Title 51 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 § 104. Character of discharge.
- 9 <u>(a) General rule. -- Whenever a particular character of</u>

Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

- 10 <u>discharge is a prerequisite to eligibility for receiving a</u>
- 11 benefit provided for in this title, an individual must have
- 12 received a discharge from service under conditions other than
- 13 <u>dishonorable</u>. Recipients of a discharge under conditions other
- 14 than dishonorable include the following:
- 15 <u>(1) A recipient of an honorable discharge.</u>
- 16 (2) A recipient of a general, under honorable
- 17 <u>conditions, discharge.</u>

18 (3) A recipient of a discharge under other than

- 1 <u>honorable conditions for which the recipient has been</u>
- 2 <u>determined to be eliqible for benefits afforded by the United</u>
- 3 States Department of Veterans Affairs.
- 4 (b) Exclusions. -- A recipient of a discharge under conditions
- 5 other than dishonorable does not include a recipient of a
- 6 <u>dishonorable</u>, <u>bad conduct or undesirable discharge</u>, or an
- 7 <u>uncharacterized discharge such as an entry-level separation.</u>
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
