## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in wiretapping and electronic 2 surveillance, further providing for exceptions to prohibition 3 of interception and disclosure of communications. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 5704(18) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 5704. Exceptions to prohibition of interception and 9 10 disclosure of communications. 11 It shall not be unlawful and no prior court approval shall be 12 required under this chapter for: \* \* \* 13 14 A person to intercept oral communications for 15 disciplinary or security purposes on a school bus or school 16 vehicle, as those terms are defined in 75 Pa.C.S. § 102 17 (relating to definitions), if all of the following conditions 18 are met: 19 The school board has adopted a policy that

- (ii) Each school year, the school board [notifies students and their parents or guardians of the policy, by letter mailed to the students' home addresses.] includes the policy in a student handbook and in any other publication of the school entity that sets forth the comprehensive rules, procedures and standards of conduct for the school entity.
- (iii) The school board posts a notice that students may be audiotaped, which notice is clearly visible on each school bus or school vehicle that is furnished with audio-recording equipment.
- This paragraph shall not apply when a school bus or school vehicle is used for a purpose that is not school related.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
