AN ACT

- 1 Prohibiting certain individuals from providing support in the
- 2 implementation of certain sections of the National Defense
- 3 Authorization Act of 2012.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Liberty
- 8 Preservation Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 "Employee." An individual employed by any of the following:
- 14 (1) The Commonwealth.
- 15 (2) A political subdivision of the Commonwealth.
- 16 (3) A corporation providing services to the
- 17 Commonwealth.
- 18 This term shall include public officials and agents for any of
- 19 the above.

- 1 Section 3. Prohibition.
- 2 No employee shall provide material support or participate in
- 3 any way with the implementation of sections 1021 and 1022 of the
- 4 National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2012 (Public
- 5 Law 112-81, 125 Stat. 1298) within the boundaries of this
- 6 Commonwealth.
- 7 Section 4. Duty of Attorney General to report certain activity.
- 8 The Attorney General shall report to the Governor and General
- 9 Assembly any attempt by agencies or agents of the Federal
- 10 Government to secure the implementation of sections 1021 and
- 11 1022 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year
- 12 2012 (Public Law 112-81, 125 Stat. 1298) through the operations
- 13 of the Federal Government, including any of its agencies,
- 14 departments, employees or agents, or through the operations of
- 15 the Commonwealth, a political subdivision of the Commonwealth or
- 16 a corporation providing services to the Commonwealth, including
- 17 any of their agencies, departments, employees or agents.
- 18 Section 5. Penalty.
- Any employee who enforces or attempts to enforce an act,
- 20 order, law, statute, rule or regulation of the Federal
- 21 Government in violation of section 3 commits a misdemeanor and
- 22 shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more
- 23 than \$500 or to imprisonment for not more than six months, or
- 24 both.
- 25 Section 6. Effective date.
- 26 This act shall take effect immediately.
