AN ACT

Amending the act of March 4, 1970 (P.L.128, No.49), entitled "An act granting to the Governor of the Commonwealth the sole 1 2 authority for regulating the display of the flag of the 3 United States from any public ground or building and from any ground or building of certain other institutions," further 5 providing for the display of the official POW/MIA flag on Commonwealth grounds or buildings. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 1 of the act of March 4, 1970 (P.L.128, 11 No.49), entitled "An act granting to the Governor of the 12 Commonwealth the sole authority for regulating the display of 13 the flag of the United States from any public ground or building and from any ground or building of certain other institutions," 14 amended May 2, 1974 (P.L.264, No.71), December 18, 1987 15 16 (P.L.417, No.87) and February 10, 1994 (P.L.70, No.5), is 17 amended to read: 18 Section 1. (a) The Governor of the Commonwealth shall have the sole power and duty for regulating the display of the flag 19

of the United States from any public ground or building of the

- 1 Commonwealth, of any board, commission or authority of the
- 2 Commonwealth created by the General Assembly, of any political
- 3 subdivision of the Commonwealth, of any school district of the
- 4 Commonwealth, or from any ground or building of any institution
- 5 which receives any State aid from the Commonwealth. The Governor
- 6 shall have the power and duty to promulgate rules and
- 7 regulations pursuant to the provisions of this section and such
- 8 rules and regulations shall be in compliance with the National
- 9 Flag Code.
- 10 (b) Notwithstanding any of the provisions of this section,
- 11 the United States flag shall be displayed daily, except during
- 12 inclement weather, at all educational institutions of higher
- 13 learning which are State-owned or receive State aid from the
- 14 Commonwealth.
- 15 (c) In addition to any other powers or duties imposed by
- 16 this section, the Governor shall require the Department of
- 17 General Services to display continuously from a flag pole in
- 18 "Soldiers' Grove," as defined in the act of October 30, 1987
- 19 (P.L.375, No.75), entitled "An act providing for the designation
- 20 of certain trees and land on the grounds of the State Capitol in
- 21 Harrisburg as 'Soldiers' Grove' in honor of war veterans;
- 22 imposing duties upon the Department of General Services; and
- 23 making an appropriation," the official POW/MIA flag until all
- 24 POW's and MIA's return or are accounted for.
- 25 (d) In addition to any other powers and duties imposed by
- 26 this section, [the Governor shall permit the display of the
- 27 official POW/MIA flag from the flagpoles of any public building
- 28 or ground in this Commonwealth.] when the United States flag is
- 29 displayed on any ground or building owned or under the control
- 30 of the Commonwealth, the official POW/MIA flag shall also be

- 1 <u>displayed where it can be reasonably accommodated.</u>
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
