1 0	(a) General rule Evcent as otherwise provided for in	

- 1 subsection (c), each licensing board in the Department of State
- 2 jurisdiction over professional licensees who are dispensers or
- 3 prescribers shall require:
- 4 <u>(1) Individuals applying for an initial license or</u>
- 5 certification issued by the licensing board, which license or
- 6 <u>certification authorizes the licensee to be a dispenser or</u>
- 7 prescriber, shall submit, no later than 12 months after
- 8 <u>obtaining an initial license or certification</u>, <u>documentation</u>
- 9 acceptable to the licensing board of the completion of at-
- 10 <u>least two hours of education in pain management and at least</u>
- 11 <u>two hours of education in the dispensing or prescribing</u>
- 12 <u>practices of opioids. The education may occur as part of the</u>
- 13 <u>applicants' professional degree educational program.</u>
- 14 (2) Dispensers and prescribers applying for the renewal
- 15 <u>of a license or certification issued by the licensing board</u>
- 16 <u>to complete at least two hours of education in pain</u>
- 17 management or two hours of education in the dispensing or
- 18 prescribing practices of opioids as a portion of the total
- 19 continuing education required for biennial renewal.
- 20 (b) Consultation with department. Each licensing board
- 21 shall, in consultation with the department, approve the
- 22 curricula for the pain management and prescribing practices of
- 23 opioids education.
- 24 (c) Exception. The requirement in subsection (a) (2) shall
- 25 not apply to a dispenser or prescriber who is exempt from the
- 26 Drug Enforcement Administration's requirements for a
- 27 registration number under 21 CFR Ch. II (relating to Drug-

- 30 <u>SECTION</u> 9.1. <u>LICENSING BOARDS TO REQUIRE EDUCATION IN PAIN</u>

1	MANAGEMENT, ADDICTION AND PRESCRIBING AND DISPENSING
2	PRACTICES FOR OPIOIDS.
3	(A) GENERAL RULE EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR IN
4	SUBSECTION (C), EACH LICENSING BOARD SHALL REQUIRE:
5	(1) INDIVIDUALS APPLYING FOR AN INITIAL LICENSE OR
6	CERTIFICATION ISSUED BY THE LICENSING BOARD, WHICH LICENSE OR
7	CERTIFICATION AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE OR CERTIFICATE HOLDER
8	TO BE A DISPENSER OR PRESCRIBER, TO SUBMIT, NO LATER THAN 12
9	MONTHS AFTER OBTAINING AN INITIAL LICENSE OR CERTIFICATION,
10	DOCUMENTATION ACCEPTABLE TO THE LICENSING BOARD OF THE
11	COMPLETION OF AT LEAST TWO HOURS OF EDUCATION IN PAIN
12	MANAGEMENT OR IDENTIFICATION OF ADDICTION AND AT LEAST TWO
13	HOURS OF EDUCATION IN THE PRACTICES OF PRESCRIBING OR
14	DISPENSING OF OPIOIDS. THE EDUCATION MAY OCCUR AS PART OF THE
15	INDIVIDUAL'S PROFESSIONAL DEGREE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM OR
16	CONTINUING EDUCATION PROGRAM.
17	(2) DISPENSERS AND PRESCRIBERS APPLYING FOR THE RENEWAL
18	OF A LICENSE OR CERTIFICATION TO COMPLETE AT LEAST TWO HOURS
19	OF CONTINUING EDUCATION IN PAIN MANAGEMENT, IDENTIFICATION OF
20	ADDICTION OR THE PRACTICES OF PRESCRIBING OR DISPENSING OF
21	OPIOIDS AS A PORTION OF THE TOTAL CONTINUING EDUCATION
22	REQUIRED FOR BIENNIAL RENEWAL.
23	(B) CONSULTATION WITH DEPARTMENT EACH LICENSING BOARD
24	SHALL, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT, APPROVE THE
25	CURRICULA FOR THE PAIN MANAGEMENT, IDENTIFICATION OF ADDICTION
26	AND THE PRACTICES OF PRESCRIBING AND DISPENSING OF OPIOIDS
27	EDUCATION.
28	(C) EXCEPTION THE REQUIREMENT IN SUBSECTION (A) (2) SHALL
29	NOT APPLY TO A PRESCRIBER WHO IS EXEMPT FROM THE DRUG
30	FNFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION'S REQUIREMENTS FOR A RECISTRATION

- 1 NUMBER UNDER 21 CFR CH. II (RELATING TO DRUG ENFORCEMENT
- 2 ADMINISTRATION, DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE) AND APPLICABLE STATE LAW
- 3 AND DOES NOT USE THE REGISTRATION NUMBER OF ANOTHER PERSON OR
- 4 ENTITY AS PERMITTED BY LAW TO PRESCRIBE CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES IN
- 5 ANY MANNER.
- 6 (D) DEFINITION. -- AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE TERM
- 7 "LICENSING BOARD" MEANS A LICENSING BOARD UNDER THE BUREAU OF
- 8 PROFESSIONAL AND OCCUPATIONAL AFFAIRS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE
- 9 WITH JURISDICTION OVER PROFESSIONAL LICENSEES OR CERTIFICATE
- 10 HOLDERS WHO ARE DISPENSERS OR PRESCRIBERS.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
