## A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating the week of March 15 through 21, 2015, as "Poison Prevention Week" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, The health and safety of this Commonwealth's
4	residents, especially children, are of utmost concern; and
5	WHEREAS, Accidental poisonings from pharmaceuticals,
6	household products and plants are pressing threats to public
7	health; and
8	WHEREAS, Of these accidental poisonings, 94% occur in the
9	home, with 35% involving children under three years of age; and
10	WHEREAS, Many of these poisonings could be avoided through
11	education and simple safety precautions; and
12	WHEREAS, The poison control centers serving this Commonwealth
13	give immediate information and treatment advice from toxicology
14	professionals regarding suspected toxic exposure to drugs,
15	chemicals and plants; and
16	WHEREAS, These poison control centers provide services 24
17	hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year; and
18	WHEREAS, These poison control centers provide services that

1 allow for poison exposures to be treated in the home, avoiding 2 unnecessary health care costs and averting panic; therefore be 3 it

4 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of March 15 5 through 21, 2015, as "Poison Prevention Week" in Pennsylvania and express appreciation to the poison control centers in this 6 Commonwealth for their efforts to promote the reduction of 7 morbidity and mortality from poisonings through the 8 9 dissemination of information about poison prevention and treatment advice, public and professional education and 10 scientific research. 11
