1 2	Recognizing the month of April 2015 as "Limb Loss Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, All Commonwealth residents should be aware of the
4	plight faced by amputees; and
5	WHEREAS, This plight includes emotional, physical and
6	financial stress; and
7	WHEREAS, Each day, more than 500 Americans lose a limb; and
8	WHEREAS, Limb loss is a lifetime condition, and the general
9	public is largely unaware of the many challenges faced by the
10	amputee community; and
11	WHEREAS, Limb loss can arise from many factors, including
12	vascular deficiencies, bone malignancies, congenital defects or
13	as the result of an accident; and
14	WHEREAS, Prosthetic devices are costly and frequently need to
15	be replaced every few years; and
16	WHEREAS, Individuals afflicted with limb loss must overcome
17	many obstacles; and

WHEREAS, The physical effects of limb loss may be the most
visible, but often the emotional difficulties that arise from
limb loss surpass the physical impacts; therefore be it
RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the month of April 2015
as "Limb Loss Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
