## A RESOLUTION

- Designating April 2015 as "Pennsylvania Community College Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, For 52 years, this Commonwealth's community colleges
- 4 have provided accessible and affordable higher education, work
- 5 force training and transfer opportunities for millions of
- 6 Pennsylvania residents; and
- 7 WHEREAS, In the current year, the community colleges serve
- 8 more than 365,000 students across 37 of this State's counties,
- 9 and 93% of credit students are residents, representing all
- 10 counties of this Commonwealth.
- 11 WHEREAS, One out of every four undergraduates of this
- 12 Commonwealth attends a community college; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Community colleges offer and support dual enrollment
- 14 of more than 11,000 high school students, representing half of
- 15 this Commonwealth's school districts; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Community colleges serve nontraditional students,
- 17 part-time students, dislocated workers and veterans in this
- 18 Commonwealth and offer increased access through online education

- 1 courses and programs, allowing students to build their academic
- 2 credentials and certifications while maintaining their work
- 3 schedules and family responsibilities; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Community colleges offer the most affordable pathway
- 5 to the baccalaureate through more than 2,700 transfer and
- 6 articulation agreements to ensure students seamlessly transition
- 7 from the community college to a four-year degree, with more than
- 8 32,800 students transferring each year; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Ninety-one percent of community college graduates
- 10 stay in Pennsylvania to live and work; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Community colleges continue to graduate students in
- 12 many of the high-demand and high-growth industries vital to the
- 13 State's economy, particularly in health care, public safety,
- 14 manufacturing and energy; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Sixty-one percent of those credit programs are in
- 16 the Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) fields; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Community colleges offer individualized credit and
- 18 noncredit courses and programs that enhance the work force
- 19 pipeline and stimulate this Commonwealth's economy; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Community colleges have developed 74 new or
- 21 redesigned programs in response to regional needs of employers
- 22 and work force trends; and
- WHEREAS, More than 1,100 employers throughout this
- 24 Commonwealth have contracted with community colleges to provide
- 25 training for more employees, and 30,200 employees have been
- 26 trained by community colleges throughout Pennsylvania; therefore
- 27 be it
- 28 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of April 2015
- 29 as "Pennsylvania Community College Month" in Pennsylvania and
- 30 encourage all residents to recognize, appreciate and support the
