A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of June 2015 as "Dairy Farmers Appreciation Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Dairy farming is the primary economic driver behind
- 4 the largest industry in this Commonwealth, which is agriculture;
- 5 and
- 6 WHEREAS, Dairy farming is a proud family tradition in
- 7 Pennsylvania, where 98% of dairy farms are owned by families and
- 8 depend on family labor; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Dairy farming is a demanding way of life that
- 10 requires healthy workers with a strong work ethic to produce the
- 11 high-quality milk and other wholesome nutritional products
- 12 enjoyed by Pennsylvania's families and the residents of other
- 13 states; and
- 14 WHEREAS, There are more than 7,400 dairy businesses, both
- 15 large and small, and 541,000 cows that produce nearly 11 billion
- 16 pounds of milk each year in this Commonwealth; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania dairy industry and related

- 1 businesses contribute more than \$5 billion annually to the
- 2 State's economy, supporting approximately 40,000 quality,
- 3 family-sustaining, stable jobs for individuals in rural
- 4 communities; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania dairy farms produce milk locally and
- 6 export it to cities and other states along the east coast of the
- 7 United States and this revenue is then reinvested in the local
- 8 community; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's dairy farms serve as the ideal model
- 10 for sustainable rural economic development, providing
- 11 stimulation to both State and local economies; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Studies show that dairy foods, when consumed as part
- 13 of a healthy diet, improve overall diet quality and may help to
- 14 reduce the risk of certain diseases; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Generations of Pennsylvania farmers have been
- 16 dedicated to the preservation of the environment, helping to
- 17 maintain the high quality of this Commonwealth's natural
- 18 resources; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's many picturesque dairy farms have
- 20 been a mainstay in the renowned beauty of the rural Pennsylvania
- 21 landscape for centuries; therefore be it
- 22 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of June 2015 as
- 23 "Dairy Farmers Appreciation Month" in Pennsylvania and recognize
- 24 the outstanding contributions of Pennsylvania's dairy farmers to
- 25 the historical, cultural, environmental and economic success of
- 26 this Commonwealth.
