A RESOLUTION

Designating the week of May 2 through 8, 2016, as "Days of 1 Remembrance of the Victims of the Holocaust" in Pennsylvania. 2 WHEREAS, From 1933 to 1945, six million Jews were murdered in 3 4 the Nazi Holocaust as part of a systematic pogrom of genocide, and millions of other people perished as victims of Nazism; and 5 6 WHEREAS, The people of this Commonwealth should always 7 remember the atrocities committed by the Nazis so that such horrors are never repeated and continually rededicate themselves 8 9 to the principle of equal justice for all people; and 10 WHEREAS, The people of this Commonwealth should remain eternally vigilant against all tyranny and recognize that 11 12 bigotry provides a breeding ground for tyranny to flourish; and 13 WHEREAS, May 5th, also recognized as 27 Nisan 5775 in the 14 Hebrew calendar, has been designated internationally as a Day of 15 Remembrance of Victims of the Nazi Holocaust, known as Yom 16 Hashoah; and

WHEREAS, It is appropriate for the people of thisCommonwealth to join in the international commemoration;

1 therefore be it

2 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of May 2 through 3 8, 2016, as "Days of Remembrance of the Victims of the 4 Holocaust" in Pennsylvania, in memory of the victims of the 5 Holocaust in the hope that we may strive to overcome prejudice 6 and inhumanity through education, vigilance and resistance.
