A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of May 15 through 21, 2016, as "Emergency Medical Services Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Emergency medical services are a vital public

- 5 WHEREAS, The members of emergency medical services teams are
- 6 ready to provide lifesaving care to those in need 24 hours a
- 7 day, seven days a week; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Access to quality emergency care dramatically
- 9 improves the survival and recovery rates of those who experience
- 10 sudden illness or injury; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The emergency medical services system consists of
- 12 emergency physicians, emergency nurses, rescue personnel,
- 13 emergency medical technicians, advanced emergency medical
- 14 technicians, paramedics, prehospital nurses, prehospital
- 15 physician extenders, air medical personnel, emergency medical
- 16 responders, emergency vehicle operators, firefighters, police
- 17 officers, educators, dispatchers, administrators and others; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The members of emergency medical services teams,
- 2 whether career or volunteer, engage in thousands of hours of
- 3 specialized training and continuing education to enhance their
- 4 lifesaving skills; and
- 5 WHEREAS, With the theme "EMS Strong: Called to Care," it is
- 6 appropriate to recognize the value and the accomplishments of
- 7 emergency medical services providers by designating "Emergency
- 8 Medical Services Week" in Pennsylvania; therefore be it
