- Commemorating the 68th anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and recognizing December 10, 2016, as 1

- 4 WHEREAS, The Universal Declaration of Human Rights was
- adopted by the United Nations General Assembly on December 10, 5
- 1948, in order to sufficiently define the rights referenced in 6
- the Charter of the United States; and 7
- WHEREAS, As chair of the United Nations Commission on Human 8
- 9 Rights, First Lady Eleanor Roosevelt was instrumental in the
- 10 drafting process of the declaration; and
- WHEREAS, The Preamble of the Universal Declaration of Human 11
- 12 Rights proclaims, "Disregard and contempt for human rights have
- 13 resulted in barbarous acts which have outraged the conscience of
- 14 mankind, and the advent of a world in which human beings shall
- 15 enjoy freedom of speech and belief and freedom from fear and
- 16 want has been proclaimed as the highest aspiration of the common
- 17 people"; and
- WHEREAS, The Universal Declaration of Human Rights has been 18

- 1 referred to as "the international Magna Carta for all mankind"
- 2 due to its intent to clarify the rights of all human beings; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Each year, December 10th is observed by individuals,
- 4 communities, religious groups, human rights organizations,
- 5 governments and the United Nations as a day to promote human
- 6 rights awareness throughout the world; and
- WHEREAS, December 10, 2016, marks the 68th anniversary of the
- 8 United Nations General Assembly adopting the Universal
- 9 Declaration of Human Rights; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the Senate commemorate the 68th anniversary of
- 11 the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and recognize December
- 12 10, 2016, as "International Human Rights Day" in Pennsylvania.
