## AN ACT

- Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in child protective services, further providing for the definition of "child abuse." 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 6303(b.1) of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, amended October 28, 2016 (P.L.966, 7 No.115), is amended to read: 8 \$ 6303. Definitions. \* \* \* 10 (b.1) Child abuse.--The term "child abuse" shall mean 11 intentionally, knowingly or recklessly doing any of the 12 13 following: 14 Causing bodily injury to a child through any 15 [recent] act or failure to act. 16 Fabricating, feigning or intentionally exaggerating 17 or inducing a medical symptom or disease which results in a
- 18 potentially harmful medical evaluation or treatment to the

- 1 child through any [recent] act.
- 2 (3) Causing or substantially contributing to serious 3 mental injury to a child through any act or failure to act or
- 4 a series of such acts or failures to act.
- 5 (4) Causing sexual abuse or exploitation of a child 6 through any act or failure to act.
- 7 (5) Creating a reasonable likelihood of bodily injury to a child through any [recent] act or failure to act.
- 9 (6) Creating a likelihood of sexual abuse or
  10 exploitation of a child through any [recent] act or failure
  11 to act.
  - (7) Causing serious physical neglect of a child.
    - (8) Engaging in any of the following recent acts:
      - (i) Kicking, biting, throwing, burning, stabbing or cutting a child in a manner that endangers the child.
      - (ii) Unreasonably restraining or confining a child, based on consideration of the method, location or the duration of the restraint or confinement.
      - (iii) Forcefully shaking a child under one year of age.
    - (iv) Forcefully slapping or otherwise striking a child under one year of age.
      - (v) Interfering with the breathing of a child.
- (vi) Causing a child to be present at a location
  while a violation of 18 Pa.C.S. § 7508.2 (relating to
  operation of methamphetamine laboratory) is occurring,
  provided that the violation is being investigated by law
  enforcement.
- 29 (vii) Leaving a child unsupervised with an 30 individual, other than the child's parent, who the actor

- 1 knows or reasonably should have known:
- 2 (A) Is required to register as a Tier II or Tier
- 3 III sexual offender under 42 Pa.C.S. Ch. 97 Subch. H
- 4 (relating to registration of sexual offenders), where
- 5 the victim of the sexual offense was under 18 years
- of age when the crime was committed.
- 7 (B) Has been determined to be a sexually violent
- 8 predator under 42 Pa.C.S. § 9799.24 (relating to
- 9 assessments) or any of its predecessors.
- 10 (C) Has been determined to be a sexually violent
- delinquent child as defined in 42 Pa.C.S. § 9799.12
- 12 (relating to definitions).
- 13 (9) Causing the death of the child through any act or
- 14 failure to act.
- 15 (10) Engaging a child in a severe form of trafficking in
- persons or sex trafficking, as those terms are defined under
- 17 section 103 of the Trafficking Victims Protection Act of 2000
- 18 (114 Stat. 1466, 22 U.S.C. § 7102).
