- In addition to the provisions of 65 Pa.C.S. Ch. 7 (relating
- 14 to open meetings), prior to entering into an agreement to sell
- 15 <u>or lease a water or sewer system owned or operated by a</u>
- 16 <u>municipal corporation or to sell or lease a water or sewer</u>
- 17 system currently operated by a municipal authority that would
- 18 require dissolution by the municipal corporation, the municipal
- 19 corporation shall hold at least one advertised public meeting,
- 20 not more than 60 days nor fewer than seven days prior to
- 21 entering into the agreement WITH THE POTENTIAL PURCHASER OR <--

- 22 LESSEE, and shall provide public notice of the meeting in all
- 23 municipalities served by the water or sewer system. THE
- 24 POTENTIAL PURCHASER OR LESSEE SHALL ATTEND THE MEETING.
