AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in high schools, providing for civics <--5 test graduation requirement ASSESSMENT OF CIVIC KNOWLEDGE. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 9 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 11 section to read: Section 1613.1. Civics Test Graduati 12 13 Notwithstanding 22 Pa. 14 15 and in each school year thereafter, each school entity shall

- 1 require a student, as a condition of high school graduation, to
- 2 <u>correctly answer at least sixty percent (60%) of the questions</u>
- 3 <u>on a test that is identical to the one hundred (100) question</u>
- 4 <u>civics test used by the United States Citizenship and</u>
- 5 Immigration Services.
- 6 (b) Each school entity may administer the test required
- 7 under subsection (a) in any grade from grades seven through
- 8 twelve, and shall:
- 9 (1) Determine the manner in which the test shall be
- 10 administered.
- 11 (2) Offer students the opportunity to take the test at least
- 12 <u>three times each year as follows:</u>
- 13 <u>(i) Once in the fall.</u>
- 14 <u>(ii) Once in the spring</u>
- 15 (iii) Once in the summer.
- 16 (3) Indicate that a student has satisfied the requirements
- 17 of this section in a student's academic record.
- 18 (c) Each student shall be permitted to take the test
- 19 <u>required under subsection (a) as many times as necessary in</u>
- 20 order to meet the requirements of this section.
- 21 (d) A student with an individualized education program shall
- 22 not be required to comply with the requirements of this section
- 23 if the provisions of the student's individualized education
- 24 program indicate otherwise.
- 25 (e) The chief school administrator of a school entity may
- 26 waive the requirements of this section for students in grade
- 27 twelve on a case by case basis for good cause in extenuating
- 28 circumstances. Waivers granted under this subsection shall not
- 29 exceed ten percent (10%) of the students in the graduating class
- 30 of the school entity.

- 1 (f) The department shall post on its publicly accessible
- 2 Internet website links to the one hundred (100) question civics
- 3 test used by the United States Citizenship and Immigration
- 4 <u>Services and any related resources offered by the United States</u>
- 5 Citizenship and Immigration Services. The department shall also
- 6 post on its publicly accessible Internet website any additional
- 7 materials that the department deems useful to school entities in
- 8 complying with the requirement in this section.
- 9 (g) Nothing in this section shall be construed to require
- 10 school entities to collect and report new data to the
- 11 <u>department.</u>
- 12 (h) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 13 <u>shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection, unless</u>
- 14 <u>the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 15 <u>"School entity" shall mean each school district, area</u>
- 16 <u>vocational technical school, intermediate unit, charter school,</u>
- 17 cyber charter school, regional charter school, or nonpublic
- 18 school from which a student may graduate high school.
- 19 <u>"Department" shall mean the Department of Education of the</u>
- 20 Commonwealth.
- 21 "Individualized education program" shall mean an
- 22 individualized education program established under 22 Pa. Code
- 23 Ch. 14 (relating to special education services and programs).
- 24 <u>SECTION 1605.1. ASSESSMENT OF CIVIC KNOWLEDGE.--(A)</u>
- 25 BEGINNING WITH THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR, EACH SCHOOL ENTITY:
- 26 (1) SHALL ADMINISTER AT LEAST ONCE TO STUDENTS DURING GRADES

- 27 <u>SEVEN THROUGH TWELVE A LOCALLY DEVELOPED ASSESSMENT OF UNITED</u>
- 28 STATES HISTORY, GOVERNMENT AND CIVICS THAT INCLUDES THE NATURE,
- 29 PURPOSE, PRINCIPLES AND STRUCTURE OF UNITED STATES
- 30 CONSTITUTIONAL DEMOCRACY, THE PRINCIPLES, OPERATIONS AND

- 1 DOCUMENTS OF UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT AND THE RIGHTS AND
- 2 RESPONSIBILITIES OF CITIZENSHIP. EACH SCHOOL ENTITY SHALL
- 3 DETERMINE THE FORM OF THE ASSESSMENT AND THE MANNER IN WHICH THE
- 4 ASSESSMENT SHALL BE ADMINISTERED AND MAY ADMINISTER THE
- 5 ASSESSMENT AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE COURSE OF STUDY REQUIRED
- 6 UNDER SECTION 1605(A) OR AT THE CONCLUSION OF ANOTHER RELATED
- 7 COURSE OR INSTRUCTIONAL UNIT. A SCHOOL ENTITY MAY USE THE UNITED
- 8 STATES CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRATION SERVICES TEST TO SATISFY THE
- 9 <u>REQUIREMENTS OF THIS PARAGRAPH.</u>
- 10 (2) SHALL ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF RECOGNITION TO STUDENTS WHO
- 11 ATTAIN A PASSING GRADE ON THE ASSESSMENT ADMINISTERED UNDER
- 12 PARAGRAPH (1).
- (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:
- 14 (1) WITHIN TWELVE (12) MONTHS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS
- 15 <u>SECTION, POST ON ITS PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE LINKS</u>
- 16 TO THE UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRATION SERVICES TEST
- 17 AND ANY RELATED RESOURCES OFFERED BY THE UNITED STATES
- 18 CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRATION SERVICES. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ALSO
- 19 POST ON ITS PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE ANY ADDITIONAL
- 20 MATERIALS THAT THE DEPARTMENT DEEMS USEFUL TO SCHOOL ENTITIES IN
- 21 COMPLYING WITH THE REQUIREMENTS IN THIS SECTION.
- 22 (2) CONDUCT AN ELECTRONIC SURVEY OF EACH SCHOOL ENTITY AT
- 23 THE CONCLUSION OF THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR AND AT THE
- 24 CONCLUSION OF EVERY SECOND SCHOOL YEAR THEREAFTER REQUESTING
- 25 INFORMATION CONCERNING COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS
- 26 SECTION. EACH SCHOOL ENTITY SHALL RESPOND TO THE SURVEY NO LATER
- 27 THAN NOVEMBER 30 FOLLOWING THE SCHOOL YEAR FOR WHICH THE SURVEY
- 28 IS CONDUCTED. THE SURVEY SHALL ONLY REQUEST THE FOLLOWING
- 29 INFORMATION FOR THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING SCHOOL YEAR:
- 30 (I) THE FORMAT OF THE ASSESSMENT ADMINISTERED AS REQUIRED

- 1 <u>UNDER SUBSECTION (A) (1).</u>
- 2 (II) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF STUDENTS WHO TOOK THE ASSESSMENT.
- 3 (III) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF STUDENTS WHO ATTAINED A PASSING
- 4 GRADE ON THE ASSESSMENT.
- 5 (IV) THE GRADE LEVEL OR LEVELS IN WHICH THE ASSESSMENT WAS
- 6 <u>ADMINISTERED.</u>
- 7 (V) THE COURSE OR COURSES IN WHICH THE ASSESSMENT WAS
- 8 ADMINISTERED.
- 9 (3) BY JANUARY 1 OF THE YEAR FOLLOWING THE SCHOOL YEAR FOR
- 10 WHICH THE SURVEY IS CONDUCTED, MAKE THE DATA COLLECTED FROM THE
- 11 SURVEYS CONDUCTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) AVAILABLE ON ITS PUBLICLY
- 12 ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE.
- 13 (C) A STUDENT WITH AN INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM SHALL
- 14 NOT BE REQUIRED TO TAKE THE ASSESSMENT ADMINISTERED UNDER
- 15 SUBSECTION (A) (1) IF THE PROVISIONS OF THE STUDENT'S
- 16 INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM INDICATE OTHERWISE.
- 17 (D) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES
- 18 SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SUBSECTION UNLESS
- 19 THE CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:
- 20 "DEPARTMENT" SHALL MEAN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION OF THE
- 21 COMMONWEALTH.
- 22 "INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM" SHALL MEAN A WRITTEN
- 23 STATEMENT FOR EACH CHILD WITH A DISABILITY THAT IS DEVELOPED,
- 24 REVIEWED OR REVISED IN A MEETING IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
- 25 INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES EDUCATION ACT (PUBLIC LAW 91-230,
- 26 20 U.S.C. § 1400 ET SEQ.) AND 22 PA. CODE CH. 14 (RELATING TO
- 27 SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES AND PROGRAMS).
- 28 "SCHOOL ENTITY" SHALL MEAN A SCHOOL DISTRICT, AREA
- 29 VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL SCHOOL, INTERMEDIATE UNIT, CHARTER SCHOOL,
- 30 CYBER CHARTER SCHOOL OR REGIONAL CHARTER SCHOOL.

- 1 "UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRATION SERVICES TEST"
- 2 SHALL MEAN THE ONE HUNDRED (100) QUESTION CIVICS TEST USED BY
- 3 THE UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRATION SERVICES.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
