12 (c) Minimum penalty. -- In addition to any other penalty

beverages to minors.

- 14 convicted of violating subsection (a) shall be sentenced to pay
- 15 a fine of not less than [\$1,000] \$3,500 or to imprisonment for
- 16 not less than one month, or both, for the first violation and a

- 18 three months, or both, for each subsequent violation. There
- 19 shall be no authority in any court to impose on an offender any

- 1 lesser sentence than the minimum sentence mandated by this
- 2 subsection. No court shall have the authority to suspend any
- 3 sentence as defined in this section. Nothing in this section
- 4 shall prevent the sentencing court from imposing a sentence
- 5 greater than the minimum sentence mandated in this subsection.
- 6 In no case shall the sentence exceed the maximum sentence
- 7 prescribed by law.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
