8	Section 1. The act of May 1, 1984 (P.L.206, No.43), known as
9	the Pennsylvania Safe Drinking Water Act, is amended by adding a
10	section to read:
11	Section 5.1. Maximum contaminant levels.
12	The Environmental Quality Board shall adopt maximum
13	contaminant levels for the following constituents:
14	<u>(1) Perfluorooctane – five parts per trillion.</u>
15	<u>(2) Perfluorooctanoic acid - five parts per trillion.</u>
16	Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
