## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial

- laws relating thereto," in preliminary provisions, providing for study of secondary school start times. 6
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows: 8
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 10
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 113.1. Study of Secondary School Start Times. -- (a)
- The Department of Education shall conduct a study of issues, 13
- benefits and options related to instituting a later start time 14
- 15 to the school day in secondary schools. The study shall:
- 16 (1) consider the recent recommendations of the American
- 17 Academy of Pediatrics on the establishment of later school start
- 18 times;
- (2) include an assessment of the health, academic and safety 19

- 1 benefits associated with establishing later start times for
- 2 secondary schools;
- 3 (3) evaluate any potential negative impacts on school
- 4 <u>districts and families that may be associated with a later</u>
- 5 school start time and consider strategies for addressing
- 6 potential problems;
- 7 (4) review all available literature and data on the
- 8 <u>experiences of school districts in other states that have</u>
- 9 instituted later school start times; and
- 10 (5) include a recommendation relating to the advisability of
- 11 <u>establishing a pilot program to test later school start times in</u>
- 12 select secondary schools in this Commonwealth that are
- 13 <u>interested in participating in the program.</u>
- 14 (b) The Department of Education shall prepare a report that
- 15 <u>includes its findings and recommendations from the study and</u>
- 16 shall provide the report to the chairman and minority chairman
- 17 of the Education Committee of the Senate and the chairman and
- 18 minority chairman of the Education Committee of the House of
- 19 Representatives no later than six months after the effective
- 20 date of this section.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
