AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in miscellaneous provisions relating to operation  
3 of vehicles, further providing for reports by police.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 3751(b)(1) and (2) of Title 75 of the  
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:

8 § 3751. Reports by police.

10 (b) Furnishing copies of report.--

11 (1) Police departments shall, upon request, furnish a  
12 certified copy of the full report of the police investigation  
13 of any vehicle accident to any person involved in the  
14 accident, his attorney or insurer, and to the Federal  
15 Government, branches of the military service, Commonwealth  
16 agencies, and to officials of political subdivisions and to  
17 agencies of other states and nations and their political  
18 subdivisions. If the request is made within 15 days of the

1 accident, the police department shall furnish an initial  
2 written report of the accident at the same time the report is  
3 delivered to the department under subsection (a). If the  
4 initial report is not complete, a supplemental report shall  
5 be submitted at a later date.

6 (2) Except as provided in paragraph (3), the cost of  
7 furnishing a copy of a report under this subsection shall not  
8 exceed [~~\$15~~] \$22.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
