AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), entitled, as amended, "An act to promote the public health and safety by 2 providing for examination, licensing and granting of permits 3 for those who desire to engage in the profession of 4 cosmetology; defining cosmetology, and regulating cosmetology 5 salons, schools, students, apprentices, teachers, managers, 6 manicurists and cosmetologists; conferring powers and duties 7 upon the Commissioner of Professional and Occupational 8 Affairs in the Department of State; providing for appeals to 9 certain courts by applicants and licensees; and providing 10 11 penalties," further providing for limited licenses. 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 5 of the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, 15 No.86), referred to as the Cosmetology Law, is amended by adding a subsection to read: 16 Section 5. Limited Licenses. -- * * * 17 (b.1) The board shall authorize an owner of a licensed 18 19 cosmetology salon who converts his cosmetology salon to a 20 limited practice to operate under the owner's current license until its expiration, at which time the owner must secure a 21 22 limited license.
