AN ACT

Amending the act of October 7, 2010 (P.L.484, No.70), entitled "An act providing for protection of abused, neglected, 2 exploited or abandoned adults; establishing a uniform 3 Statewide reporting and investigative system for suspected 4 abuse, neglect, exploitation or abandonment of adults; 5 providing for protective services; and prescribing 6 penalties," in reporting suspected abuse by employees, providing for Statewide adult abuse registry. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of October 7, 2010 (P.L.484, No.70), 11 12 known as the Adult Protective Services Act, is amended by adding 1.3 a section to read: Section 508. Statewide adult abuse registry. 14 15 (a) Establishment. -- The department shall establish a Statewide registry of individuals who have been convicted of: 16 17 (1) simple assault under 18 Pa.C.S. § 2701 (relating to simple assault) if the victim is 18 years of age or older; 18 (2) aggravated assault under 18 Pa.C.S. § 2702 (related 19

- 1 <u>to aggravated assault) if the victim is 18 years of age or</u>
- 2 older; or
- 3 (3) neglect of a care-dependent person under 18 Pa.C.S.
- 4 § 2713 (relating to neglect of care-dependent person).
- 5 (b) Registry information. -- The registry shall include, but
- 6 not be limited to, the following:
- 7 (1) The name, Social Security number, age, sex and
- 8 <u>address of the individual convicted of a crime under</u>
- 9 <u>subsection (a).</u>
- 10 (2) A description of the crime committed under
- 11 <u>subsection (a), including the date or dates of the incidents.</u>
- 12 <u>(c) Employer requirement.--Employers shall require</u>
- 13 prospective employees to submit with their applications for
- 14 employment a certification from the department that the
- 15 prospective employee's name does not appear on the registry. The
- 16 <u>certificate must be obtained within the one-year period of the</u>
- 17 submission date of the application.
- 18 (d) Regulations. -- The department shall promulgate the
- 19 regulations necessary to carry out this section.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
