AN ACT

Amending the act of June 25, 1982 (P.L.633, No.181), entitled, as reenacted and amended, "An act providing for independent 1 2 oversight and review of regulations, creating an Independent 3 Regulatory Review Commission, providing for its powers and duties and making repeals," further providing for definitions, for final-form regulations and final-omitted 5 regulations and procedures for review, for procedures for 7 disapproval of final-form and final-omitted regulations and 8 9 emergency-certified regulations, for procedures for subsequent review of disapproved final-form or final-omitted 10 regulations and for changes in final-form and final-omitted 11 12 regulations. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Section 3 of the act of June 25, 1982 (P.L.633, 16 No.181), known as the Regulatory Review Act, is amended by adding a definition to read: 17 Section 3. Definitions. 18 19 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall 20 have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the 21 meanings given to them in this section:

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- 1 <u>"Recommendation notice." A report adopted by a majority vote</u>
- 2 of the Independent Regulatory Review Commission recommending the
- 3 approval or disapproval of a final-form or final-omitted
- 4 regulation according to the criteria established in section 5.2.
- 5 * * *
- 6 Section 2. Sections 5.1(e), (g), (j.1), (j.2) and (j.3), 6,
- 7 7 and 8 of the act are amended to read:
- 8 Section 5.1. Final-form regulations and final-omitted
- 9 regulations; procedures for review.
- 10 * * *
- 11 (e) The commission may have until its next scheduled meeting
- 12 which occurs no less than 30 days after receipt of the final-
- 13 form or final-omitted regulation to [approve or disapprove the
- 14 final-form or final-omitted regulation. The commission shall
- 15 notify the agency and the committees of its approval or
- 16 disapproval.] issue a recommendation notice to the committees
- 17 and the agency. If the commission does not [disapprove the
- 18 final-form or final-omitted regulation] issue a recommendation
- 19 notice within the time allotted in this subsection, the
- 20 commission shall be deemed to have [approved] recommended the
- 21 approval of the final-form or final-omitted regulation and shall
- 22 notify the committees.
- 23 * * *
- 24 (q) Except as provided in this subsection, the agency may
- 25 not make any changes to a final-form or final-omitted regulation
- 26 after the agency submits the final-form or final-omitted
- 27 regulation to the commission and the committees.
- 28 (1) Prior to [the expiration of the date on which either
- 29 of the committees takes action on the final-form or final-
- omitted regulation, pursuant to subsection (j.2) or (j.3) or]

- 1 the expiration of the commission's review period prescribed 2 in subsection (e), [whichever occurs first,] the agency may, unless the commission or a committee shall object, toll the 3 4 time for the commission's and the committees' review of the 5 final-form or final-omitted regulation in order to allow time 6 for the agency to consider revisions to the final-form or 7 final-omitted regulation recommended by the commission or a 8 committee.
 - (2) Tolling under paragraph (1) may last for up to 30 days. If within 30 days the agency does not submit revisions to the committees and the commission or does not notify the commission and the committees in writing that it will not submit revisions but wishes the commission and the committees to resume their review, the agency shall be deemed to have withdrawn the final-form or final-omitted regulation.
- The [committees shall have the remainder of the 20-16 17 day review period or ten days from the date of receipt of the 18 revised final-form or final-omitted regulation or written 19 notification under paragraph (2), whichever is longer, to 20 take action pursuant to subsection (j.2) or (j.3), and the] 21 commission may have until its next scheduled meeting which 22 occurs [after the expiration of the committee review period 23 but] not less than 15 days after receipt of the revised 24 final-form or final-omitted regulation or written 25 notification under paragraph (2) to review the final-form or 26 final-omitted regulation and issue a recommendation notice to 27 the committees. If the commission does not [disapprove the 28 final-form or final-omitted regulation or a committee does 29 not notify the commission and the agency that it has 30 disapproved the regulation or that it intends to review the

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- 1 regulation pursuant to subsection (j.2), within the
- 2 respective time periods, the regulation shall be deemed
- approved.] issue a recommendation notice within this time
- 4 <u>period, the commission shall be deemed to have recommended</u>
- 5 the approval of the final-form or final-omitted regulation
- 6 and shall notify the committees. The committees shall, within
- 7 <u>12 session days from the date of receiving the recommendation</u>
- 8 <u>notice required by this section, take action pursuant to</u>
- 9 subsection (j.1).
- 10 (4) The agency may not toll the time for review of any
- 11 final-form or final-omitted regulation more than one time.
- 12 (5) The agency may not submit revisions or notification
- 13 that the regulation will not be revised after the adjournment
- sine die or the expiration of the legislative session in an
- even-numbered year. If the committees and the commission are
- 16 prevented from completing their review pursuant to this
- 17 subsection because of the adjournment sine die or the
- 18 expiration of the legislative session in an even-numbered
- 19 year, the agency shall resubmit the final-form or final-
- 20 omitted regulation and review shall proceed in accordance
- within subsection [(j.3)] (j.1).
- 22 * * *
- 23 (j.1) [A committee shall have at least 20 days from receipt
- 24 of the information required under subsection (a) or receipt of
- 25 the information required under subsection (c) to] The committees_
- 26 shall, within 12 session days of receiving notification from the
- 27 <u>commission required by subsection (e),</u> take action pursuant to
- 28 subsection (j.2). If the committees are prevented from
- 29 completing their [20-day] review within 12 session days because
- 30 of the adjournment sine die or expiration of the legislative

- 1 session in an even-numbered year, their review of the final-form
- 2 or final-omitted regulation shall automatically be suspended
- 3 until the fourth Monday in January of the next year. On that
- 4 date, the agency shall resubmit the final-form or final-omitted
- 5 regulation and required material to the committees and the
- 6 commission. If either committee has not been designated by the
- 7 fourth Monday in January, the agency may not deliver the final-
- 8 form or final-omitted regulation and required material to the
- 9 commission and the committees until both committees have been
- 10 designated. If the agency does not deliver the final-form or
- 11 final-omitted regulation and required material to the commission
- 12 and the committees by the second Monday after the date by which
- 13 both committee designations have been published in the
- 14 Pennsylvania Bulletin, the agency shall be deemed to have
- 15 withdrawn the regulation. In computing the remaining time for
- 16 committee review, the number of <u>session</u> days in which the
- 17 committees have had the final-form or the final-omitted
- 18 regulation under review as of the adjournment sine die or
- 19 expiration of the prior session shall be subtracted from the [20
- 20 day] <u>12-session-day</u> committee review period, but the committee
- 21 review period in the next succeeding legislative session shall
- 22 not be less than [ten] three session days. The commission shall
- 23 not act on a regulation until the committee review period has
- 24 expired. This section shall not apply to emergency-certified
- 25 regulations adopted pursuant to the provisions of section 6(d).
- 26 (j.2) [At any time during the commission's review period up
- 27 to 24 hours prior to the opening of the commission's public
- 28 meeting, a committee may notify the commission and the agency
- 29 that it has approved or disapproved a final-form or final-
- 30 omitted regulation or that it intends to review the regulation.

- 1 If the commission approves a regulation and a committee has not
- 2 notified the commission and the agency that it has disapproved
- 3 the regulation or that it intends to review the regulation, the
- 4 agency may promulgate the regulation. If the commission approves
- 5 a regulation and a committee has notified the commission and the
- 6 agency that it has disapproved the regulation or that it intends
- 7 to review the regulation, the agency may not promulgate the
- 8 regulation for 14 days after the committee has received the
- 9 commission's approval order. During this 14-day period, the
- 10 committee may take action on the regulation pursuant to section
- 11 7(d). If at the expiration of the 14-day period the committee
- 12 has not taken action on the regulation pursuant to section 7(d),
- 13 the agency may promulgate the regulation.
- 14 (j.3) If the committees are prevented from completing their
- 15 14-day review because of adjournment sine die or expiration of
- 16 the legislative session in an even-numbered year, their review
- 17 of the final-form or final-omitted regulation shall
- 18 automatically be suspended until the fourth Monday in January of
- 19 the next year. On that date, the agency shall resubmit the
- 20 final-form or final-omitted regulation and required material to
- 21 the committees and the commission. If either committee has not
- 22 been designated by the fourth Monday in January, the agency may
- 23 not deliver the final-form or final-omitted regulation and
- 24 required material to the committees and the commission until
- 25 both committees are designated. If the agency does not deliver
- 26 the final-form or final-omitted regulation and required material
- 27 to the commission and the committees by the second Monday after
- 28 the date by which both committee designations have been
- 29 published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin, the agency shall be
- 30 deemed to have withdrawn the final-form or final-omitted

- 1 regulation. In determining the remaining time for committee
- 2 review, the number of days in which the committees have had the
- 3 final-form or the final-omitted regulation under review as of
- 4 the adjournment sine die or expiration of the prior session
- 5 shall be subtracted from the 14-day committee review period, but
- 6 the committee review period in the next succeeding legislative
- 7 session shall not be less than ten days. An agency may not
- 8 submit a final-form or final-omitted regulation to the
- 9 commission or the committees for review during the period from
- 10 the adjournment sine die or expiration of the legislative
- 11 session of an even-numbered year to the date by which both
- 12 committees have been designated in the next succeeding
- 13 legislative session. This subsection shall not apply to
- 14 emergency-certified regulations adopted pursuant to the
- 15 provisions of section 6(d).] Both committees shall approve or
- 16 disapprove of the final-form or final-omitted regulation. An
- 17 agency may not promulgate the final-form or final-omitted
- 18 regulation until both committees approve the regulation. If a
- 19 <u>committee disapproves the final-form or final-omitted</u>
- 20 regulation, the agency shall be barred from promulgating the
- 21 regulation and shall proceed further with the final-form or
- 22 <u>final-omitted regulation pursuant to section 7.</u>
- 23 * * *
- 24 Section 6. Procedures for disapproval of final-form and final-
- omitted regulations; emergency-certified regulations.
- 26 (a) [If the commission disapproves a final-form or final-
- 27 omitted regulation, the] The commission shall deliver its
- 28 [disapproval order] <u>recommendation notice</u> to the Legislative
- 29 Reference Bureau, the committees and the agency. The commission
- 30 shall notify commentators who have requested additional

- 1 information under section 5.1(a) of the commission's [vote to
- 2 disapprove. The disapproval order] recommendation notice. If the
- 3 <u>recommendation notice advises the committees to disapprove a</u>
- 4 <u>final-form or final-omitted regulation</u>, the recommendation
- 5 <u>notice</u> shall specify the regulatory review criteria which the
- 6 final-form or final-omitted regulation has not met. [The agency
- 7 shall review the commission's order and proceed pursuant to
- 8 section 7(a).]
- 9 (b) [The commission's order disapproving] A committee's vote
- 10 to disapprove a final-form or final-omitted regulation shall bar
- 11 the agency from promulgating that regulation pending subsequent
- 12 review under section 7. An agency may not promulgate a final-
- 13 <u>form or final-omitted regulation until both committees have</u>
- 14 approved the regulation.
- 15 (c.1) If a committee disapproves a final-form or final-
- 16 <u>omitted regulation</u>, the committee shall deliver a disapproval
- 17 order to the Legislative Reference Bureau, the commission and
- 18 the agency. The disapproval order shall specify the regulatory
- 19 review criteria which the final-form or final-omitted regulation
- 20 has not met and may include any suggested revisions to the
- 21 regulation the committee may have. The agency shall review the
- 22 <u>committee's disapproval order and proceed pursuant to section 7.</u>
- 23 (d) [The commission] <u>A committee</u> may not issue an order
- 24 barring an agency from promulgating a final-form or final-
- 25 omitted regulation if the Attorney General certifies that the
- 26 final-form or final-omitted regulation is required pursuant to
- 27 the decree of any court or to implement the provisions of a
- 28 statute of the United States or regulations issued thereunder by
- 29 a Federal agency or if the Governor certifies that the final-
- 30 form or final-omitted regulation is required to meet an

- 1 emergency which includes conditions which may threaten the
- 2 public health, safety or welfare; cause a budget deficit; or
- 3 create the need for supplemental or deficiency appropriations of
- 4 greater than \$1,000,000. In those cases, the final-form or
- 5 final-omitted regulation may take effect on the date of
- 6 publication or on a later date specified in the order adopting
- 7 the final-form or final-omitted regulation. The commission and
- 8 the committees shall review the final-form or final-omitted
- 9 regulation pursuant to the procedures provided for in this act.
- 10 If the final-form or final-omitted regulation is disapproved
- 11 pursuant to those procedures, that regulation shall be rescinded
- 12 after 120 days or upon final disapproval, whichever occurs
- 13 later.
- 14 Section 7. Procedures for subsequent review of disapproved
- final-form or final-omitted regulations.
- 16 (a) [An agency may select one of the following options for
- 17 proceeding with a regulation which has been disapproved by the
- 18 commission:
- 19 (1) To proceed further with the final-form or final-
- omitted regulation pursuant to subsection (b).
- 21 (2) To proceed further with the final-form or final-
- 22 omitted regulation pursuant to subsection (c).
- 23 (3) To withdraw the final-form or final-omitted
- 24 regulation.
- 25 (b) If the agency decides to adopt the final-form or final-
- 26 omitted regulation without revisions or further modifications,
- 27 the agency shall submit a report to the committees and the
- 28 commission within 40 days of the agency's receipt of the
- 29 commission's disapproval order. The agency's report shall
- 30 contain the final-form or final-omitted regulation, the

- 1 commission's disapproval order and the agency's response and
- 2 recommendations regarding the final-form or final-omitted
- 3 regulation. If the committees are prevented from receiving the
- 4 report because of adjournment sine die or expiration of the
- 5 legislative session in an even-numbered year, the agency shall
- 6 submit its report to the commission and the committees on the
- 7 fourth Monday in January of the next year. If either committee
- 8 has not been designated by the fourth Monday in January, the
- 9 agency may not deliver the report to the committees and the
- 10 commission until both committees are designated, but the agency
- 11 shall deliver its report to the commission and the committees no
- 12 later than the second Monday after the date by which both
- 13 committee designations have been published in the Pennsylvania
- 14 Bulletin. If the agency does not deliver the report to the
- 15 committees and the commission in the time prescribed in this
- 16 subsection, the agency shall be deemed to have withdrawn the
- 17 final-form or final-omitted regulation.] <u>If a committee</u>
- 18 disapproves a final-form or final-omitted regulation, the agency
- 19 shall withdraw the final-form or final-omitted regulation or
- 20 proceed further with the regulation pursuant to subsection (c).
- 21 (c) If the agency decides to revise or modify the final-form
- 22 or final-omitted regulation in order to respond to objections
- 23 raised by the commission or by a committee and adopt that
- 24 regulation with revisions or modifications, the agency shall
- 25 submit a report to the committees and the commission within 40
- 26 days of the agency's receipt of the [commission's] committee's
- 27 disapproval order. The agency's report shall contain the revised
- 28 final-form or final-omitted regulation, the findings of the
- 29 commission and the committees, and the agency's response and
- 30 recommendations regarding the revised final-form or final-

- 1 omitted regulation. If the committees are prevented from
- 2 receiving the report because of adjournment sine die or
- 3 expiration of the legislative session in an even-numbered year,
- 4 the agency shall submit the report to the commission and the
- 5 committees on the fourth Monday in January of the next year. If
- 6 either committee has not been designated by the fourth Monday in
- 7 January, the agency may not deliver the report to the committees
- 8 and the commission until both committees are designated, but the
- 9 agency shall deliver its report to the commission and the
- 10 committees no later than the second Monday after the date by
- 11 which both committee designations have been published in the
- 12 Pennsylvania Bulletin. If the agency does not deliver its report
- 13 to the commission and the committees in the time prescribed in
- 14 this subsection, the agency shall be deemed to have withdrawn
- 15 the final-form or final-omitted regulation.
- 16 (c.1) The commission may have until its next scheduled
- 17 meeting, which occurs no less than 15 days from receipt of the
- 18 agency's report to [approve or disapprove the agency's report.
- 19 The commission shall deliver its approval or disapproval order]
- 20 <u>issue a recommendation notice</u> to the committees for
- 21 consideration [by the General Assembly] pursuant to subsection
- 22 (d). If the commission is prevented from delivering [its order]
- 23 the recommendation notice to the committees within the time
- 24 period provided for in this subsection because of the
- 25 adjournment sine die or expiration of the legislative session in
- 26 an even-numbered year, the commission shall deliver its order on
- 27 the fourth Monday of January of the next year. If either
- 28 committee has not been designated by the fourth Monday in
- 29 January, the commission may not deliver its order to the
- 30 committees until both committees are designated, but the

- 1 commission shall deliver its order no later than the second
- 2 Monday after the date by which both committee designations have
- 3 been published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin. If the commission
- 4 does not deliver its order disapproving the agency's report and
- 5 revised final-form or final-omitted regulation in the time
- 6 prescribed by this subsection, the commission shall be deemed to
- 7 have approved the agency's report and the revised final-form or
- 8 final-omitted regulation and shall notify the committees.
- 9 (d) Upon receipt of the commission's [order] recommendation
- 10 <u>notice or notification</u> pursuant to subsection (c.1) [or at the
- 11 expiration of the commission's review period if the commission
- 12 does not act on the regulation or does not deliver its order
- 13 pursuant to subsection (c.1), one or] both of the committees
- 14 [may, within 14 calendar days, report to the House of
- 15 Representatives or Senate a concurrent resolution and notify the
- 16 agency. During the 14-calendar-day period, the agency may not
- 17 promulgate the final-form or final-omitted regulation. If, by
- 18 the expiration of the 14-calendar-day period, neither committee
- 19 reports a concurrent resolution, the committees shall be deemed
- 20 to have approved the final-form or final-omitted regulation, and
- 21 the agency may promulgate that regulation. If either committee
- 22 reports a concurrent resolution before the expiration of the 14-
- 23 day period, the Senate and the House of Representatives shall
- 24 each have 30 calendar days or ten legislative days, whichever is
- 25 longer, from the date on which the concurrent resolution has
- 26 been reported, to adopt the concurrent resolution. If the
- 27 General Assembly adopts the concurrent resolution by majority
- 28 vote in both the Senate and the House of Representatives, the
- 29 concurrent resolution shall be presented to the Governor in
- 30 accordance with section 9 of Article III of the Constitution of

- 1 Pennsylvania. If the Governor does not return the concurrent
- 2 resolution to the General Assembly within ten calendar days
- 3 after it is presented, the Governor shall be deemed to have
- 4 approved the concurrent resolution. If the Governor vetoes the
- 5 concurrent resolution, the General Assembly may override that
- 6 veto by a two-thirds vote in each house. The Senate and the
- 7 House of Representatives shall each have 30 calendar days or ten
- 8 legislative days, whichever is longer, to override the veto. If
- 9 the General Assembly does not adopt the concurrent resolution or
- 10 override the veto in the time prescribed in this subsection, it
- 11 shall be deemed to have approved the final-form or final-omitted
- 12 regulation. Notice as to any final disposition of a concurrent
- 13 resolution considered in accordance with this section shall be
- 14 published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin. The bar on promulgation
- 15 of the final-form or final-omitted regulation shall continue
- 16 until that regulation has been approved or deemed approved in
- 17 accordance with this subsection. If the General Assembly adopts
- 18 the concurrent resolution and the Governor approves or is deemed
- 19 to have approved the concurrent resolution or if the General
- 20 Assembly overrides the Governor's veto of the concurrent
- 21 resolution, the agency shall be barred from promulgating the
- 22 final-form or final-omitted regulation. If the General Assembly
- 23 does not adopt the concurrent resolution or if the Governor
- 24 vetoes the concurrent resolution and the General Assembly does
- 25 not override the Governor's veto, the agency may promulgate the
- 26 final-form or final-omitted regulation. The General Assembly
- 27 may, at its discretion, adopt a concurrent resolution
- 28 disapproving the final-form or final-omitted regulation to
- 29 indicate the intent of the General Assembly but permit the
- 30 agency to promulgate that regulation.] shall, within six session

- 1 days, review the revised final-form or final-omitted regulation.
- 2 If a committee disapproves the revised final-form or final-
- 3 <u>omitted regulation</u>, the agency shall withdraw the revised final-
- 4 <u>form or final-omitted regulation or proceed further with the</u>
- 5 revised final-form or final-omitted regulation pursuant to
- 6 <u>subsection</u> (c). If both committees approve the revised final-
- 7 form or final-omitted regulation, the agency may promulgate the
- 8 regulation. If the committees are prevented from completing
- 9 their review within six session days because of the adjournment
- 10 sine die or expiration of the legislative session in an even-
- 11 <u>numbered year, their review of the final-form or final-omitted</u>
- 12 regulation shall automatically be suspended until the fourth
- 13 Monday in January of the next year. On that date, the agency
- 14 shall resubmit the final-form or final-omitted regulation and
- 15 required material to the committees and the commission. If
- 16 either committee has not been designated by the fourth Monday in
- 17 January, the agency may not deliver the final-form or final-
- 18 omitted regulation and required material to the commission and
- 19 the committees until both committees have been designated. If
- 20 the agency does not deliver the final-form or final-omitted
- 21 regulation and required material to the commission and the
- 22 committees by the second Monday after the date by which both
- 23 committee designations have been published in the Pennsylvania
- 24 Bulletin, the agency shall be deemed to have withdrawn the
- 25 regulation. In computing the remaining time for committee
- 26 review, the number of session days in which the committees have
- 27 <u>had the final-form or the final-omitted regulation under review</u>
- 28 as of the adjournment sine die or expiration of the prior
- 29 session shall be subtracted from the six-session-day committee
- 30 review period, but the committee review period in the next

- 1 <u>succeeding legislative session shall not be less than three</u>
- 2 <u>session days</u>. The commission may not act on a regulation until
- 3 the committee review period has expired. This section does not
- 4 apply to emergency-certified regulations adopted pursuant to the
- 5 provisions of section 6(d).
- 6 Section 8. Changes in final-form and final-omitted regulations.
- 7 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), an agency may not
- 8 make changes to a final-form or final-omitted regulation after
- 9 that regulation has been approved [or has been deemed approved]
- 10 by the committees [or the commission] pursuant to this act.
- 11 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to changes made at the
- 12 direction of the Office of Attorney General pursuant to its
- 13 review under section 204(b) of the Commonwealth Attorneys Act.
- 14 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
