AN ACT

Amending the act of December 18, 1984 (P.L.1005, No.205), entitled, as amended, "An act mandating actuarial funding 2 standards for all municipal pension systems; establishing a 3 recovery program for municipal pension systems determined to 4 be financially distressed; providing for the distribution of the tax on the premiums of foreign fire insurance companies; 5 6 and making repeals," in standards for municipal pension 7 systems, further providing for definitions and providing for 8 special procedures for certain professional services 9 contracts. 10 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. The definition of "professional service contract" 14 in section 701-A of the act of December 18, 1984 (P.L.1005, 15 No.205), known as the Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard 16 and Recovery Act, is amended to read: Section 701-A. Definitions. 17 18 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter 19 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 20 context clearly indicates otherwise: 21 * * * "Professional services contract." A contract to which [the] 22

- 1 <u>a</u> municipal pension system <u>having 100 or more active members</u> is
- 2 a party that is:
- 3 (1) for the purchase or provision of professional
- 4 services, including investment services, legal services, real
- 5 estate services and other consulting services; and
- 6 (2) not subject to a requirement that the lowest bid be
- 7 accepted.
- 8 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 Section 702.1-A. Special procedures for certain professional
- 10 <u>services contracts.</u>
- 11 The governing body of each municipal pension plan system,
- 12 having less than 100 active members, shall select the most
- 13 qualified person to enter into a contract to administer, manage
- 14 or service the municipal pension plan. To ensure that the
- 15 <u>availability of a contract to administer, manage or service a</u>
- 16 <u>municipal pension plan is provided to potential participants</u>,
- 17 the governing body shall:
- 18 (1) Announce at two consecutive regularly scheduled
- 19 public meetings the availability of the contract.
- 20 (2) Post the availability of the contract on the
- 21 official Internet website of the municipality, if any, for a
- 22 period of no less than two weeks.
- 23 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
