AN ACT

- 1 Providing for child-care expense considerations in financial aid 2 determinations by postsecondary educational institutions.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Child-care expense considerations in financial aid
- 6 determinations.
- 7 (a) General rule. -- In determining the amount of financial
- 8 aid a student is eligible to receive in an academic year, a
- 9 postsecondary educational institution shall consider if the
- 10 student will incur child-care expenses during that academic
- 11 year. If it is determined that the student will incur child-care
- 12 expenses, the postsecondary educational institution shall use
- 13 that as a factor in calculating the amount of financial aid to
- 14 which the student is entitled.
- 15 (b) Definition.--As used in this section, the term
- 16 "postsecondary educational institution" means an institution of
- 17 the State System of Higher Education as provided in Article XX-A

- 1 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the
- 2 Public School Code of 1949, a State-related institution as
- 3 defined in section 2001-D of that act and a community college as
- 4 defined in section 1901-A of that act.
- 5 Section 2. Effective date.
- 6 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
