Section 6332 of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection-8 9 SUBSECTIONS to read: <--10 § 6332. Establishment of Statewide toll-free telephone number. 11 12 (c) Posting Statewide toll-free telephone number in 13 schools. -- All public and nonpublic schools that enroll students 14 in grades kindergarten through 12 shall publicly display at each 15 school campus a poster UNIFORMLY DESIGNED BY THE DEPARTMENT that <-contains the Statewide toll-free telephone number for reporting 16 suspected child abuse or neglect. The poster shall be 11 inches <--17

- 1 by 17 inches or larger and of a uniform design approved by the
- 2 department in consultation with the Department of Education. The
- 3 <u>poster shall be posted in a high-traffic, public area of the</u>
- 4 school that is readily accessible to and widely used by
- 5 <u>students. The DEPARTMENT SHALL, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE</u> <--
- 6 <u>DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, DESIGN THE POSTER TO BE 11 INCHES BY 17</u>
- 7 INCHES OR LARGER, DISPLAY THE Statewide toll-free telephone
- 8 <u>number, WHICH shall be printed in bold print. The poster shall</u> <--
- 9 <u>also</u>, AND include the department's publicly accessible Internet <--
- 10 website that provides information and resources related to child
- 11 protection. THE DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL <--
- 12 MAKE THE POSTER AVAILABLE ON THEIR PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET
- 13 WEBSITES TO ALL PUBLIC AND NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS.
- 14 (D) POSTING STATEWIDE TOLL-FREE TELEPHONE NUMBER IN
- 15 HOSPITALS.--ALL HOSPITALS SHALL PUBLICLY DISPLAY A POSTER THAT
- 16 CONTAINS THE STATEWIDE TOLL-FREE TELEPHONE NUMBER FOR REPORTING
- 17 SUSPECTED CHILD ABUSE OR NEGLECT. THE POSTER SHALL BE 11 INCHES
- 18 BY 17 INCHES OR LARGER AND OF A UNIFORM DESIGN APPROVED BY THE
- 19 DEPARTMENT IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH. THE
- 20 POSTER SHALL BE POSTED IN A HIGH-TRAFFIC, PUBLIC AREA OF THE
- 21 EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT OF THE HOSPITAL. THE STATEWIDE TOLL-FREE
- 22 TELEPHONE NUMBER SHALL BE PRINTED IN BOLD PRINT. THE POSTER
- 23 SHALL ALSO INCLUDE THE DEPARTMENT'S PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET
- 24 WEBSITE THAT PROVIDES INFORMATION AND RESOURCES RELATED TO CHILD
- 25 PROTECTION.
- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
