AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous 3 articles, further providing for sale or transfer of firearms. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 6111(f)(2) of Title 18 of the 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and the subsection is amended by adding a paragraph to read: 8 § 6111. Sale or transfer of firearms. * * * 10 11 (f) Application of section. --12 13 The provisions contained in subsections (a) and (c)

shall only apply to pistols or revolvers with a barrel length

of less than 15 inches, any shotgun with a barrel length of

less than 18 inches, any rifle with a barrel length of less

3 than 16 inches or any firearm with an overall length of less

4 than 26 inches.]

- 6 (5) The provisions contained in subsection (b) (3), (4)
- 7 <u>and (5) shall not apply to the sale or transfer of a firearm</u>
- 8 by a licensed importer, licensed manufacturer, licensed
- 9 dealer or county sheriff if all of the following requirements

- 11 (i) The sale or transfer of the firearm occurs at a
- 12 <u>lawful gun show, meet or auction.</u>
- 13 <u>(ii) The purchaser or transferee presents a receipt</u>
- described in subsection (b) (5) demonstrating that the
- 15 <u>purchaser or transferee obtained a unique approval number</u>
- obtained within the preceding 72 hours at the same gun
- show, meet or auction.
- 18 (iii) The purchaser or transferee presents a valid
- license to carry a firearm, issued under section 6109.
