15	(c) ExceptionAny person who has never held a hunting
16	license in Pennsylvania or any other state may participate in
17	the hunting and trapping activities authorized under this title
18	or commission regulations without compliance with subsection (a)

1 or section 2704 (relating to eligibility for license) if that 2 person satisfies all of the following requirements:

3 (1)The person who participates in the hunting or trapping activities must always be in sight of and close 4 5 enough to a licensed hunter who is at least 18 years of age to clearly hear and understand instructions communicated to 6 7 the person through normal conversation without the aid of any 8 device. The licensed hunter shall have a valid hunting 9 license for the game or wildlife they are hunting or qualify 10 for license and fee exemptions under section 2706 (relating 11 to [resident] license and fee exemptions).

(b) Hunter education. -- Persons who have not held a hunting 15 16 license lawfully issued to them in this Commonwealth or another 17 state or nation or have not hunted under the exceptions in 18 section 2706 (relating to [resident] license and fee exemptions) 19 or do not possess a certificate of training approved by the 20 director prior to the enactment of this title shall be required to attain accreditation in a hunter education program approved 21 by the director before a hunting license is issued to them. The 22 23 provisions of this subsection shall not apply to a person who 24 presents:

26 § 2705. Classes of licenses.

27 Unless otherwise provided, any person wishing to exercise any 28 of the privileges granted by this title shall first secure the 29 applicable resident or nonresident hunting or furtaker license 30 as follows:

(15) Elk hunting license to persons eligible for classes 2 3 of licenses in paragraphs (1), (2), (3), (7), (7.1), (8), (9) and (11.1). Notwithstanding any other provisions of this 4 5 title or the regulations promulgated thereunder, elk licenses 6 under this paragraph shall not be subject to the provisions 7 of sections 2706 (relating to [resident] license and fee 8 exemptions) and 2706.1 (relating to complimentary nonresident 9 licenses). To ensure sound management of Pennsylvania's wild elk population, the commission may promulgate regulations to 10 establish a limited number of licenses. The commission may 11 12 establish a nonrefundable application fee at a cost of \$10. \* \* \* 13

16 (b) Disabled veterans.--

17 Any resident or nonresident disabled veteran who has (1)18 a disability incurred in any war or armed conflict which 19 consists of the loss of one or more limbs, or the loss of the 20 use of one or more limbs, or who is 100% disabled as 21 certified by the United States Department of Veterans 22 Affairs, and who meets all other qualifications of this title 23 and is otherwise mentally and physically fit, shall be issued 24 a free regular hunting or furtaking license upon application 25 to the commission or a county treasurer.

(1.1) Any <u>resident or nonresident</u> disabled veteran who
has a disability incurred in any war or armed conflict and
possesses a disability rating between 60% and 99% as
certified by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
and who meets all other qualifications of this act and is

1 otherwise mentally and physically fit shall be issued a resident hunting or furtaking license at the cost of \$1 upon 2 3 application to the commission or a county treasurer.

5 (b.1) Prisoners of war. -- A resident or nonresident former prisoner of war shall be entitled to purchase a resident hunting 6 7 license at the cost of \$1 plus the current issuing fee upon 8 application to the commission. An application under this subsection shall contain the same information as is required for 9 other resident hunting license applications. As used in this 10 subsection, the term "former prisoner of war" means an 11 12 individual who was imprisoned by enemy forces while in the 13 service of the armed forces of the United States as certified by 14 the appropriate branch of the armed forces of the United States. 15 \* \* \*

Section 2. Section 2709(a)(2) and (17) of Title 34 are 16 17 amended and the subsection is amended by adding a paragraph to 18 read:
