(b) Basis to report.--

(1) A mandated reporter enumerated in subsection (a) shall make a report of suspected child abuse in accordance with section 6313 (relating to reporting procedure), if the mandated reporter has reasonable cause to suspect that a child is a victim of child abuse under any of the following circumstances:

(iii) [A] The mandated reporter witnesses an abusive act to an identifiable child or a person makes a specific disclosure to the mandated reporter that an identifiable child is the victim of child abuse.

- [(I)] (II) THE MANDATED REPORTER COMES INTO CONTACT WITH THE CHILD IN THE COURSE OF EMPLOYMENT, OCCUPATION AND PRACTICE OF A PROFESSION OR THROUGH A REGULARLY SCHEDULED PROGRAM, ACTIVITY OR SERVICE.
- [(II)] (III) THE MANDATED REPORTER IS DIRECTLY
 RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CARE, SUPERVISION, GUIDANCE OR
 TRAINING OF THE CHILD, OR IS AFFILIATED WITH AN AGENCY,
 INSTITUTION, ORGANIZATION, SCHOOL, REGULARLY ESTABLISHED
 CHURCH OR RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION OR OTHER ENTITY THAT IS
 DIRECTLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CARE, SUPERVISION, GUIDANCE
 OR TRAINING OF THE CHILD.
