Section 6311(a)(16) and $\frac{b}{1}$ (B) of Title 23 of <-the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 8 § 6311. Persons required to report suspected child abuse. 10 Mandated reporters. -- The following adults shall make a 11 report of suspected child abuse, subject to subsection (b), if 12 the person has reasonable cause to suspect that a child is a victim of child abuse: 13 * * * 14 15 An adult family member who is a person responsible 16 for the child's welfare and provides services to a child in a family living home, community home for individuals with an 17

intellectual disability or host home for children which are

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- subject to supervision or licensure by the department under
- 2 Articles IX and X of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31,
- No.21), known as the [Public Welfare] Human Services Code.
- 4 (b) Basis to report.--

- (1) A mandated reporter enumerated in subsection (a) shall make a report of suspected child abuse in accordance with section 6313 (relating to reporting procedure), if the mandated reporter has reasonable cause to suspect that a child is a victim of child abuse under any of the following circumstances:
- (i) The mandated reporter witnesses an act of child <--

 - f(ii) fiii) The mandated reporter is directly responsible for the care, supervision, guidance or training of the child, or is affiliated with an agency, institution, organization, school, regularly established church or religious organization or other entity that is directly responsible for the care, supervision, guidance or training of the child.
- f(iv) f(v) An individual 14 years of age or older <-makes a specific disclosure to the mandated reporter that
 the individual has committed child abuse.
