Nonmunicipal police extraterritorial jurisdiction. 12 (a) Power and authority.--In addition to a power and 13 authority vested by law, a nonmunicipal police officer who is 14 within this Commonwealth, but beyond the territorial limit of the jurisdiction established for the officer's nonmunicipal\_ 15 police department by law, shall have the power and authority to 16 enforce the laws of this Commonwealth or to perform a function 17 18 of a municipal police officer in the following circumstances: 19 (1) If the officer is in hot pursuit of a person for an 20 offense which was committed, or which the officer has 21 probable cause to believe was committed, within the officer's 22 jurisdiction and for which the officer continues in fresh 23 pursuit of the person after the commission of the offense. 24 (2) If the officer has been requested to aid or assist a 25 Federal, State or local law enforcement officer or park 26 police officer or has probable cause to believe that the other officer is in need of aid or assistance. 27 (3) If, while on official business, the officer views an 28 29 offense and makes a reasonable effort to identify himself or 30 herself as a police officer and the offense is:
