## AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1
- Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for a 2
- special license plate for female veterans.
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4
- hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- § 1364.2. Special plates for female veterans. 8
- 9 Upon application of any person who is an honorably discharged
- 10 female veteran of the armed forces of the United States or a
- 11 reserve component of the armed forces as defined in 51 Pa.C.S. §
- 12 7301 (relating to definitions), accompanied by a fee of \$35
- which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by 13
- 14 documentation as the department shall require, the department
- 15 shall issue to the person a special registration plate
- 16 designating the vehicle as belonging to a person who is a female
- 17 veteran of the armed forces of the United States. The special

- 1 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck
- 2 with a registered gross weight of not more than 10,000 pounds.
- 3 Fifteen dollars of the fee paid by the applicant for the special
- 4 <u>registration plate shall be transferred to the Veterans' Trust</u>
- 5 Fund. The portion of the fee transferred to the Veterans' Trust
- 6 Fund under this subsection shall be used for programs and
- 7 resources that assist female veterans.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
