## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in reimbursements by Commonwealth and
- between school districts, further providing for student-
- 7 weighted basic education funding.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 2502.53(b) of the act of March 10, 1949
- 11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
- 12 amended to read:
- 13 Section 2502.53. Student-Weighted Basic Education Funding.--
- 14 \* \* \*
- 15 (b) For the [2015-2016] 2017-2018 school year [and each
- 16 school year thereafter], the Commonwealth shall pay to each
- 17 school district a basic education funding allocation which shall
- 18 consist of the following:
- 19 (1) An amount equal to the school district's basic education

- 1 funding allocation for the 2013-2014 school year.
- 2 (2) A student-based allocation to be calculated as follows:
- 3 (i) Multiply the school district's student-weighted average
- 4 daily membership by the median household income index and local
- 5 effort capacity index.
- 6 (ii) Multiply the product in subparagraph (i) by the
- 7 [difference between the amount appropriated for the allocation
- 8 of basic education funding to school districts and the amount
- 9 appropriated for the allocation in paragraph (1).] total amount
- 10 distributed to all school districts for basic education funding
- 11 for the 2016-2017 school year.
- 12 (iii) Divide the product in subparagraph (ii) by the sum of
- 13 the products in subparagraph (i) for all school districts.
- 14 <u>(iv) Subtract the amount allocated to each school district</u>
- 15 for basic education funding for the 2016-2017 school year from
- 16 the amount for each school district as calculated according to
- 17 subparagraph (iii).
- 18 (v) For each school district in which the difference as
- 19 <u>calculated in subparagraph (iv) is greater than zero, the school</u>
- 20 district shall receive an amount distributed as follows:
- 21 (A) Subtract the amount allocated for basic education
- 22 funding in the 2016-2017 school year from the amount
- 23 appropriated for the 2017-2018 school year.
- (B) Multiply the difference from clause (A) by seventy-five
- 25 percent (75%).
- 26 (C) Multiply the product from clause (B) by the positive
- 27 <u>difference from subparagraph (iv) for each qualifying school</u>
- 28 <u>district</u>.
- 29 (D) Divide the product from clause (C) by the sum of the
- 30 positive amounts as calculated under subparagraph (iv) for all

- 1 qualifying school districts.
- 2 (vi) Each school district shall also receive an additional
- 3 amount as follows:
- 4 (A) Multiply the school district's student-weighted average
- 5 daily membership by the median household income index and local
- 6 <u>effort capacity index.</u>
- 7 (B) Subtract the amount allocated for basic education
- 8 <u>funding for the 2016-2017 school year from the amount</u>
- 9 appropriated for the 2017-2018 school year.
- 10 (C) Multiply the difference from clause (B) by twenty-five
- 11 <u>percent (25%).</u>
- 12 (D) Subtract the total amount distributed under paragraph
- 13 (1) from the total amount allocated to all school districts for
- 14 <u>the 2016-2017 school year.</u>
- 15 (E) Add the product from clause (C) and the difference from
- 16 clause (D).
- 17 (F) Multiply the amount for each school district from clause
- 18 (A) by the sum from clause (E).
- (G) Divide the product from clause (F) by the sum of the
- 20 products in clause (A) for all school districts.

- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018, or
- 23 immediately, whichever is later.
