## A RESOLUTION

1 2	Recognizing March 14, 2017, as "Rare Disease Day" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Nearly 1 in 10 individuals living in this
4	Commonwealth has a rare disease, and, according to the National
5	Institutes of Health, nearly 30 million Americans have rare
6	diseases; and
7	WHEREAS, A disease is considered rare if it affects fewer
8	than 200,000 Americans; and
9	WHEREAS, There are nearly 7,000 rare diseases; and
10	WHEREAS, Rare diseases tend to be lifelong, and approximately
11	two-thirds of individuals affected are children; and
12	WHEREAS, "Rare Disease Day" is observed nationwide by
13	millions across the country and by the National Organization for
14	Rare Disorders to promote special awareness of rare diseases;
15	and
16	WHEREAS, Special events and activities are planned in

schools, hospitals, universities and medical schools, including
the sharing of stories by individuals affected by a rare
disease; therefore be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize March 5 14, 2017, as "Rare Disease Day" in Pennsylvania in order to show 6 residents of this Commonwealth living with a rare disease that, 7 while their diseases are rare, they are not alone.
