A RESOLUTION

- Designating June 1, 2017, as "Child Welfare Caseworker Appreciation Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Every day in this Commonwealth thousands of children
- 4 are at risk of child abuse and neglect or have been removed from
- 5 their homes due to abuse and neglect; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives recognizes the need to
- 7 intervene to protect Pennsylvania's children; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Commonwealth child welfare caseworkers are
- 9 responsible for the difficult tasks of investigating child
- 10 abuse, providing services to families, assessing safety,
- 11 initiating steps to protect children and providing services to
- 12 ensure that children are provided with healthy and nurturing
- 13 care and support as they transition into adulthood and needed
- 14 services in an effort to reunify families; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The work of caseworkers requires them to enter into

- 1 situations in which their personal safety may be put at risk;
- 2 and
- 3 WHEREAS, Child welfare caseworkers work in severely trying
- 4 and emotional situations with children who have been victimized
- 5 by physical abuse, sexual abuse, neglect and other forms of
- 6 maltreatment; and
- 7 WHEREAS, To be successful, child welfare caseworkers must
- 8 develop great skill in working with families who are in crisis
- 9 situations, struggling with mental health challenges, suffering
- 10 from drug and alcohol conditions, poverty and other difficult
- 11 issues; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Child welfare caseworkers selflessly undertake the
- 13 endeavor of protecting the children of this Commonwealth, often
- 14 with low pay, long hours, tremendous demands, little
- 15 appreciation and great criticism, all of which has a dramatic
- 16 impact on their personal lives; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Every year caseworkers are injured or killed in
- 18 their pursuit to protect children across the United States; and
- 19 WHEREAS, These risks were poignantly demonstrated by the
- 20 intentional firebombing of the Luzerne County Children and Youth
- 21 Services office on March 6, 2017; and
- 22 WHEREAS, In 2015, caseworkers in Pennsylvania investigated
- 23 40,590 reports of child abuse and neglect; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Innumerable injuries and deaths of children have
- 25 been averted due to the efforts of child welfare caseworkers;
- 26 therefore be it
- 27 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate June 1,
- 28 2017, as "Child Welfare Caseworker Appreciation Day" in
- 29 Pennsylvania.
