A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing May 25, 2017, as "Red Nose Day" in Pennsylvania.

2 WHEREAS, "Red Nose Day" began more than 25 years ago as a way  
3 to provide essential services to children in impoverished  
4 communities all around the world; and

5 WHEREAS, "Red Nose Day," in association with Walgreens,  
6 provides food, clothing, shelter and medical care to help get  
7 children off the streets; and

8 WHEREAS, Through this program, children in developing  
9 countries are provided with tuition, supplies and textbooks in  
10 order to enhance their access to education; and

11 WHEREAS, At-risk children are given a safe place to learn and  
12 play during the summer and after school; and

13 WHEREAS, Hungry children are given meals through Feeding  
14 America food banks; and

15 WHEREAS, All 50 states and many global communities are given

1 support to help nurture their youth; and

2 WHEREAS, In 2016, 2,659,642 children's lives were positively  
3 impacted by the "Red Nose Day" initiative; and

4 WHEREAS, Since 2015, "Red Nose Day" in America has raised  
5 more than \$60 million to help kids and young people most in  
6 need; therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize May 25,  
8 2017, as "Red Nose Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it further

9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives acknowledge the  
10 positive impact "Red Nose Day" has on children living in poverty  
11 in Pennsylvania, the United States and around the world.
