- Recognizing the week of October 1 through 7, 2017, as "National Newspaper Week" in Pennsylvania.

- 5 informed public, and that its citizens must have access to the
- 6 most complete and accurate information about their community,
- 7 their nation and the world; and
- 8 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth is the birthplace of our nation's
- 9 independence, and the freedom enjoyed by the people of the
- 10 United States, supported by the right to free speech and a free
- 11 press, is a treasured principle upon which Pennsylvania and
- 12 America thrive; and
- 13 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth's newspapers have evolved through
- 14 the centuries to meet the increasing needs and challenges of a
- 15 diverse population to reflect the highest standards of
- 16 journalism and public service, accuracy and fairness; and

- 2 Inc., has sponsored and supported "National Newspaper Week," a
- 3 weeklong celebration emphasizing the importance of newspapers in
- 4 fostering improved community service, participation and
