A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the 200th anniversary of Hope United Methodist
- Church, formerly known as Salem United Methodist Church.
- 3 WHEREAS, Hope United Methodist Church, formerly known as
- 4 Salem United Methodist Church, in Mechanicsburg is the location
- 5 of the historic Salem Chapel; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The history of Salem Chapel can be traced as far
- 7 back as 1818, when the Salem Meeting House was erected on land
- 8 then known as the Stayman farm; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Salem Chapel was deeded to the Methodist Episcopal
- 10 Church for \$100 in 1882, making Salem Chapel the oldest
- 11 Methodist church building in regular use in the Cumberland
- 12 Valley; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Historical records show that the Confederate Army
- 14 fired artillery from the churchyard in 1863; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Salem Chapel was closed in 1922 and was reopened in
- 16 1953 by members of the Wesley United Methodist Church in

- 1 Mechanicsburg; and
- 2 WHEREAS, In 1997, a new sanctuary was built for regular
- 3 Sunday services, and the Salem Chapel continues to be used for
- 4 many special services; therefore be it
- 5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 6 200th anniversary of Hope United Methodist Church, formerly
- 7 known as Salem United Methodist Church.
