A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing April 28, 2018, as "National Prescription Drug Take-2 Back Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, On April 28, 2018, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., the
- 4 United States Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) will provide
- 5 the public with a free and anonymous opportunity to safely rid
- 6 their homes of potentially dangerous expired, unused and
- 7 unwanted prescription drugs; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The DEA, along with local agencies, began holding
- 9 "National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day" in 2010, and it has
- 10 proven so successful that it has grown into a semiannual event;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, During the most recent "National Prescription Drug
- 13 Take-Back Day" held in October 2017, Americans turned in 456
- 14 tons of prescription drugs at more than 5,000 sites operated by
- 15 the DEA and more than 4,200 of its state and local law

- 1 enforcement partners; and
- 2 WHEREAS, In Pennsylvania there were 211 law enforcement
- 3 participants and 303 collection sites collecting over 18 tons of
- 4 prescription drugs; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Since the inaugural "National Prescription Drug
- 6 Take-Back Day" in 2010, the DEA and its partners have collected
- 7 more than 9 million pounds of prescription drugs or
- 8 approximately 4,500 tons of pills; and
- 9 WHEREAS, This initiative addresses a vital public safety and
- 10 public health issue; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Unwanted, unused or expired medications that
- 12 languish in home medicine cabinets or medications that are not
- 13 disposed of properly are highly susceptible to diversion, misuse
- 14 and abuse; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Rates of prescription drug abuse in the United
- 16 States are alarmingly high, as are the number of accidental
- 17 poisonings and overdoses due to these drugs; and
- 18 WHEREAS, According to the American Society of Addiction
- 19 Medicine (ASAM), four out of five new heroin users started out
- 20 misusing prescription medications; and
- 21 WHEREAS, ASAM reports that as a result, the rate of heroin
- 22 overdose deaths nearly quadrupled from 2000 to 2013; and
- 23 WHEREAS, According to the Centers for Disease Control and
- 24 Prevention there were more than 63,600 drug overdose deaths in
- 25 the United States in 2016; and
- 26 WHEREAS, According to the DEA, a majority of abused
- 27 prescription drugs are obtained from family and friends,
- 28 including from the home medicine cabinet; therefore be it
- 29 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize April
- 30 28, 2018, as "National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day" in

1 Pennsylvania.
