## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in development, providing for lease extended by production.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 58 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 3213.1. Lease extended by production.
9	(a) ProhibitionAny portion of land subject to a lease
10	that is combined with other lands or leases to form a unit shall
11	be subject to operations and production on and in the unit. The
12	operations and production shall continue a lease in force and
13	effect during or after the primary term according to the lease
14	provisions only as to that portion of the leased land that is
15	included in the unit. Any land covered by a lease and not
16	included in the unit shall not be subject to operations or
17	production on or in the unit. The lease may be kept in force in
18	any manner provided in the lease agreement for leased land not

1 <u>included in an agreement.</u>

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2	(b) Applicability
3	(1) Subsection (a) shall apply to any unit formed after
4	the effective date of this section.
5	(2) This section shall only apply to lease interests in
6	<u>an unconventional reservoir.</u>
7	(c) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
8	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
9	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
10	"Unconventional reservoir." A formation below the base of
11	the Elk Sandstone or its geologic equivalent stratigraphic
12	interval that contains or produces oil or gas that generally
13	cannot be economically produced at flow rates or in volumes
14	except by hydraulic fracturing, horizontal or multilateral well
15	bores or other techniques to expose the reservoir to the well
16	bore.
17	"Unit." A consolidation of interests of persons actively
18	engaged in the business of extracting oil or gas from land owned
19	or leased by the persons within a defined geographic area to
20	facilitate the drilling of wells from one or more unconventional
21	reservoirs.

22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
