8	§ 2502. Murder.

10	(b) Murder of the second degreeA criminal homicide
11	constitutes murder of the second degree when it is committed
12	[while] <u>by:</u>
13	<u>(1) a</u> defendant [was] engaged as a principal or an
14	accomplice in the perpetration of a felony[.]; or
15	(2) an accomplice of a defendant engaged as a principal
16	or accomplice in the perpetration of a felony and the
17	defendant intentionally, knowingly or recklessly disregarded
18	the risk that the death of another human being would occur as
19	a result of their participation in the perpetration of the

1 <u>felony.</u>

3 Section 2. Any person who has been sentenced before the 4 effective date of this act for a violation of 18 Pa.C.S. § 5 2502(b) (relating to murder) shall be entitled to a review by 6 the court to determine whether there is a need for a 7 resentencing hearing as a result of this act. Persons deemed by 8 the court to need a resentencing hearing shall be resentenced in 9 accordance with law.

10 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
