8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Sections 19(10) and 33 of the act of December 22,
10	1983 (P.L.306, No.84), known as the Board of Vehicles Act, are
11	amended to read:
12	Section 19. Grounds for disciplinary proceedings.
13	In addition to any criminal or civil penalties otherwise
14	provided in this act, the board shall have the power to formally
15	reprimand, suspend or revoke any license or refuse to issue or
16	renew any license of an applicant or licensee or a person
17	required to be licensed under this act, if after due notice of
18	and hearing, the person charged is found in violation of or
19	fails to carry out the acts and procedures set forth in this act

or is found guilty of committing or attempting to commit any of 1 the acts set forth in section 23 or any of the following acts: 2 * * * 3 (10) Having engaged in the buying, selling, exchanging, 4 5 trading or otherwise dealing in vehicles on Sunday in violation of 18 Pa.C.S. § 7365 (relating to trading in motor 6 vehicles and trailers) [.], except that: 7 8 (i) Manufactured housing is permitted to be sold on Sundays by licensed manufactured housing dealers without 9 10 being subject to prosecution under this paragraph. 11 (ii) Licensed motorcycle dealers are permitted to 12 buy, sell, exchange, trade or otherwise deal in 13 motorcycles on Sunday without being subject to 14 prosecution under this paragraph. (iii) Motor vehicles are permitted to be sold on 15 Sundays by normal vehicle business dealers pursuant to 16 section 33(5) without being subject to prosecution under 17 18 this paragraph. * * * 19 Section 33. [Off-premise sales] <u>Sales</u>, shows, exhibitions or 20 21 rallies on Sundays. (1) 22 The following shall be permitted to be open on 23 Sundays: 24 (i) Off-premise vehicle sales, shows and 25 exhibitions. 26 (ii) Recreational vehicle shows, recreational 27 vehicle off-premise sales, recreational vehicle exhibitions and recreational vehicle rallies. 28 29 Except as provided in paragraphs (3) [and], (4) and (2) (5), normal vehicle business practices shall be allowed at 30

off-premise sales, vehicle shows or exhibitions on Sunday
 except that no final sales contract may be consummated on a
 Sunday.

4 (3) Normal vehicle business practices shall be allowed
5 at recreational vehicle shows, recreational vehicle off6 premise sales, recreational vehicle exhibitions and
7 recreational vehicle rallies. Recreational vehicle dealers
8 are permitted to consummate final sales contracts on Sundays.

9 (4) Manufactured housing dealers are permitted to 10 consummate final sales contracts on Sundays.

11 (5) Normal vehicle business dealers shall be permitted

12 to be open Sundays for on-premise sales and shall be

13 permitted to consummate final sales contracts on Sundays.

14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
