BETWEEN THE KINGPIN AND THE CENTER LINE OF THE REAR AXLE OR
 REAR AXLE GROUP DOES NOT EXCEED 41 FEET OR, IN THE CASE OF A
 TRAILER USED EXCLUSIVELY OR PRIMARILY TO TRANSPORT VEHICLES
 IN CONNECTION WITH MOTOR SPORTS COMPETITION EVENTS, DOES NOT
 EXCEED 46 FEET.

6 (2) FOR A DOUBLE TRAILER, THE LENGTH OF EACH TRAILER
7 BEING TOWED IN COMBINATION BY A TRUCK TRACTOR SHALL NOT
8 EXCEED 28 1/2 FEET.

9 (3) THE OVERALL LENGTH OF THE COMBINATION OF A TRUCK 10 TRACTOR WITH A CONVENTIONAL FIFTH WHEEL AND AN AUTO OR BOAT 11 TRANSPORTER SHALL NOT EXCEED 65 FEET, EXCLUSIVE OF AN 12 OVERHANG OF NOT MORE THAN THREE FEET ON THE FRONT AND FOUR 13 FEET ON THE REAR OF THE COMBINATION.

14 (4) THE OVERALL LENGTH OF A STINGER-STEERED AUTO OR BOAT 15 TRANSPORTER COMBINATION SHALL NOT EXCEED [75] 80 FEET, 16 EXCLUSIVE OF AN OVERHANG OF NOT MORE THAN [THREE] FOUR FEET ON THE FRONT AND [FOUR] SIX FEET ON THE REAR OF THE 17 18 COMBINATION. A STINGER-STEERED AUTOMOBILE TRANSPORTER SHALL 19 NOT BE PROHIBITED FROM THE TRANSPORT OF CARGO OR GENERAL FREIGHT ON A BACKHAUL IF THE STINGER-STEERED AUTOMOBILE 20 TRANSPORTER COMPLIES WITH THE WEIGHT LIMITATIONS FOR A TRUCK 21 22 TRACTOR AND SEMITRAILER COMBINATION.

23 (5) THE OVERALL LENGTH OF A SADDLE-MOUNT COMBINATION
24 SHALL NOT EXCEED 75 FEET.

25 (6) THE OVERALL LENGTH OF A MAXI-CUBE COMBINATION SHALL26 NOT EXCEED 65 FEET.

27 (7) A COMBINATION CONSISTING OF ANY TOW TRUCK TOWING A
28 DISABLED MOTOR VEHICLE TO A PLACE OF REPAIRS OR OTHER PLACE
29 OF SAFETY.

30 (8) A COMBINATION TRANSPORTING ARTICLES THAT,

3 (9) THE OVERALL LENGTH OF A TOWAWAY TRAILER TRANSPORTER
4 COMBINATION SHALL NOT EXCEED 82 FEET.

5 (C) DEFINITIONS.--AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING
6 WORDS AND PHRASES SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS
7 SUBSECTION:

8 "AUTOMOBILE OR BOAT TRANSPORTER." A TRUCK OF A TOTAL LENGTH 9 NOT GREATER THAN 45 FEET, EXCLUSIVE OF AN OVERHANG OF NOT MORE 10 THAN THREE FEET ON THE FRONT AND FOUR FEET ON THE REAR OF THE 11 VEHICLE CONFIGURED BY THE MANUFACTURER TO HAUL EITHER 12 AUTOMOBILES, LIGHT TRUCKS OR BOATS.

13 <u>"TOWAWAY TRAILER TRANSPORTER COMBINATION." AS FOLLOWS:</u>

14 (1) A COMBINATION OF VEHICLES CONSISTING OF A TRAILER

15 TRANSPORTER TOWING UNIT AND TWO TRAILERS OR SEMITRAILERS WITH

16 <u>A TOTAL WEIGHT THAT DOES NOT EXCEED 26,000 POUNDS; AND</u>

17 (2) THE TRAILERS OR SEMITRAILERS CARRY NO PROPERTY AND

18 <u>CONSTITUTE INVENTORY PROPERTY OF A MANUFACTURER, DISTRIBUTOR</u>

19 OR DEALER OF THE TRAILERS OR SEMITRAILERS.

20 <u>"TRAILER TRANSPORTER TOWING UNIT." A POWER UNIT THAT IS NOT</u>

21 USED TO CARRY PROPERTY WHEN OPERATING IN A TOWAWAY TRAILER

22 TRANSPORTER COMBINATION.

23 Section 2. Section 4941(a) of Title 75 is amended and the 24 section is amended by adding a subsection to read:

25 § 4941. Maximum gross weight of vehicles.

(a) General rule.--[No] <u>Except as provided for in subsection</u>
(d), no vehicle shall, when operated upon a highway, have a
gross weight exceeding 80,000 pounds, and no combination driven
upon a highway shall have a gross weight exceeding 80,000
pounds, or the applicable weight set as forth in subsection (b)

3	<u>(d) Natural gas vehicles</u>
4	(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a
5	vehicle that is operated by an engine fueled primarily by
6	compressed or liquefied natural gas may exceed the gross
7	vehicle weight limits imposed under this section by an
8	amount, not to exceed a maximum of 2,000 pounds, that is
9	equal to the difference between the weight of the vehicle
10	attributable to the natural gas tank and fueling system
11	carried by the vehicle and the weight of a comparable diesel
12	tank and fueling system.
13	(2) The weight exemption provided for under this
14	subsection shall apply to all STATE HIGHWAYS AND interstate <
15	highways as provided by the exemption permitted under 23
16	U.S.C. § 127 (relating to vehicle weight limitations

2	Section 4 5. Title 75 is amended by adding a section to-
3	read:
4	<u>§ 4979.7. Permit for movement of freight via natural gas</u>
5	vehicles.
6	An annual permit may be issued authorizing the movement on
7	specified highways of freight as allowed by law by a vehicle
8	powered by natural gas, be it compressed or liquefied, which
9	exceeds the maximum vehicle gross weight specified in section
10	4941 (relating to maximum gross weight of vehicles). The weight
11	of any vehicle permitted under this section may not exceed
12	82,000 pounds overall gross weight and 21,000 pounds on any
13	steering axle.
14	Section 5 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days. <
