- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in preliminary provisions, providing
- for impact of scores from assessments.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 121.1. Impact of Scores from Assessments.--(a)</u>
- 13 Notwithstanding any law or regulation to the contrary, beginning
- 14 in the 2017-2018 school year, student scores on an assessment
- 15 <u>shall be attributed to a student's school entity for the sole</u>
- 16 purpose of compliance with the Every Student Succeeds Act
- 17 (Public Law 114-95, 129 Stat. 1802).
- 18 (b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent
- 19 the use of student scores on an assessment to calculate academic
- 20 growth using statistically reliable measures.

- 1 (c) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 2 <u>shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless</u>
- 3 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 4 <u>"Assessment." The Pennsylvania System of School Assessment</u>
- 5 test, the Keystone Exam, an equivalent local assessment or
- 6 <u>another test established or approved by the State Board of</u>
- 7 Education or the General Assembly to meet the requirements of
- 8 section 2603-B(d)(10)(i) and required under the Every Student
- 9 <u>Succeeds Act or its successor statute.</u>
- 10 "Public school entity." Includes a school district,
- 11 <u>intermediate unit</u>, <u>joint school</u>, <u>area vocational-technical</u>
- 12 <u>school</u>, <u>charter school or cyber charter school</u>.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
