- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in registration plates, providing for special
- 3 plates for veterans of an ally foreign country.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 1369.3. Special plates for veterans of an ally foreign
- 9 <u>country.</u>
- 10 Upon application of a person who was a citizen of a foreign
- 11 country that allied with the United States in a military
- 12 conflict and served in a military branch of that foreign country
- 13 during the military conflict, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which
- 14 shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by such <--
- 15 <u>documentation as the department shall require, the department</u>
- 16 <u>shall issue to the person a special registration plate</u>
- 17 designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who
- 18 is a veteran of a military branch of a foreign country that

- 1 <u>allied with the United States in a military conflict. The</u>
- 2 <u>special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car</u>
- 3 or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000
- 4 pounds.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 120 days. <--
