AN ACT

1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
 2 Statutes, in hunting and furtaking licenses, further  
 3 providing for license costs and fees.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
 5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 2709(a) of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania  
 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 2709. License costs and fees.

9 (a) License costs.--Any person who qualifies under the  
 10 provisions of this chapter shall be issued the applicable  
 11 license upon payment of the following costs and the issuing  
 12 agent's fee:

13 (1) (i) Junior resident hunting - \$5.

14 (ii) Junior resident combination hunting and  
 15 furtaker - \$8.

16 (2) (i) Adult resident hunting - [~~\$19~~] \$29.

17 (ii) Resident military personnel hunting - \$1.

18 (iii) Former prisoner of war hunting - \$1.

19 (iv) Pennsylvania National Guard hunting - \$1.

- 1 (v) Reserve component of the armed forces hunting -  
2 \$1.
- 3 (3) (i) Senior resident hunting - \$12.  
4 (ii) Senior lifetime resident hunting - \$50.  
5 (iii) Senior lifetime resident combination hunting  
6 and furtaker - \$100.
- 7 (4) Bear hunting:  
8 (i) Resident - [~~\$15~~] \$20.  
9 (ii) Nonresident - [~~\$35~~] \$40.
- 10 (5) Antlerless deer:  
11 (i) Resident, including resident military, resident  
12 disabled veteran and landowner - [~~\$5~~] \$10.  
13 (ii) Nonresident - [~~\$25~~] \$40.
- 14 (6) Archery deer:  
15 (i) Resident - [~~\$15~~] \$20.  
16 (ii) Nonresident - [~~\$25~~] \$40.
- 17 (7) Muzzleloader deer:  
18 (i) Resident - [~~\$10~~] \$20.  
19 (ii) Nonresident - [~~\$20~~] \$40.
- 20 (8) (Reserved).
- 21 (9) Adult nonresident hunting - [~~\$100~~] \$150.
- 22 (10) (i) Junior nonresident hunting - \$40.  
23 (ii) Junior nonresident combination hunting and  
24 furtaker - \$50.
- 25 (11) Seven-day nonresident small game - [~~\$30~~] \$50.
- 26 (12) Junior resident furtakers - \$5.
- 27 (13) Adult resident furtakers - [~~\$19~~] \$29.
- 28 (14) (i) Senior resident furtakers - \$12.  
29 (ii) Senior lifetime resident furtaker - \$50.
- 30 (15) Adult nonresident furtaker - [~~\$80~~] \$100.

1 (16) Junior nonresident furtaker - \$40.

2 (17) Resident disabled veteran hunting or furtaker under  
3 section 2706(b) (relating to disabled veterans) - no cost.

4 (18) Replacement license - \$5. Antlerless deer and bear  
5 licenses shall be replaced by the original issuing agent  
6 only.

7 (19) Owners or possessors of land open to public hunting  
8 under section 2706(d) (relating to owners or possessors of  
9 land open to public hunting) - \$3.

10 (20) Migratory game bird hunting license:

11 (i) Resident - [~~\$2~~] \$5.

12 (ii) Nonresident - [~~\$5~~] \$10.

13 (21) Elk hunting license:

14 (i) Resident - \$25.

15 (ii) Nonresident - \$250.

16 (22) Special wild turkey license:

17 (i) Resident - [~~\$20~~] \$25.

18 (ii) Nonresident - [~~\$40~~] \$50.

19 (23) (i) Senior nonresident hunting - \$100.

20 (ii) Senior nonresident furtaker - \$80.

21 (iii) Senior nonresident combination hunting and  
22 furtaker - \$150.

23 (24) Ultimate outdoorsman combination license, including  
24 bear, archery, muzzleloader, furtaker, migratory game bird  
25 and special wild turkey:

26 (i) Resident - \$110.

27 (ii) Nonresident - \$350.

29 Section 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
