AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in preliminary provisions, providing for prohibition of the use of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act.

- 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a

- 13 Section 126. Prohibition of the Use of the Pennsylvania
- 14 Prevailing Wage Act. -- (a) No contract entered into by a school
- 15 district, charter school, cyber charter school or institution of
- 16 <u>higher education under this act for a public work</u>, as defined in
- 17 section 2 of the act of August 15, 1961 (P.L.987, No.442), known
- 18 <u>as the "Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act," shall be subject to</u>
- 19 the "Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act."
- 20 (b) As used in this section, the following words and phrases

- 1 <u>shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection:</u>
- 2 "Charter school." As defined in section 1703-A of this act.
- 3 "Cyber charter school." As defined in section 1703-A of this
- 4 <u>act.</u>
- 5 "Institution of higher education." As defined in section
- 6 <u>1901-F of this act.</u>
- 7 Section 2. The addition of section 126 of the act shall
- 8 apply to any contract entered into on or after the effective
- 9 date of this section.
- 10 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
