## AN ACT

Amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses) and 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in nuisances, further 2 providing for the offense of scattering rubbish; in 3 registration of vehicles and in licensing of drivers, further providing for the acknowledgment of littering provisions; and, in miscellaneous provisions, further providing for the 6 offense of depositing of waste and other material on highway, property or waters. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 11 Section 1. Section 6501(b)(1) and (2) of Title 18 of the 12 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the 13 subsection is amended by adding paragraphs to read: § 6501. Scattering rubbish. 14 15 16 (b) Penalty. --17 A person who violates subsection (a) (1) or (2) is 18 guilty of a summary offense for the first offense and upon 19 conviction thereof shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not 20 less than \$50 nor more than [\$300] \$1,000 or to imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or both, as provided in paragraph 21

1 (6).

(2) A person who violates subsection (a) (1) or (2) is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree for the second and subsequent offense and upon conviction thereof shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than [\$300] \$100 nor more than [\$1,000] \$2,000, as provided in paragraph (6). The person also may be sentenced to imprisonment or to performing a community service for a period not to exceed one year.

## (6) Fines shall be imposed as follows:

- (i) For littering of five pounds or less for the first offense, the fine shall be not less than \$50 nor more than \$300.
- (ii) For littering of more than five pounds but less than 100 pounds or 25 cubic feet for the first offense, the fine shall be not less than \$300 nor more than \$500.
- (iii) For littering of more than 100 pounds or 25 cubic feet or more for the first offense, the fine shall be not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000.
- (iv) For littering of less than five pounds for the second and subsequent offense, the fine shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$500.
- (v) For littering of more than five pounds but less than 100 pounds or 25 cubic feet for the second and subsequent offense, the fine shall be not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000.
- (vi) For littering of more than 100 pounds or 25

  cubic feet for the second and subsequent offense, the

  fine shall be not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$2,000.

  (7) Two-thirds of any fine over \$300 collected under

- 1 paragraph (1) or (2) for an offense that occurred in a county
- 2 that has established a litter board or any other authority,
- 3 <u>organization, department, bureau or board established by the</u>
- 4 <u>county to administer solid waste management as designated by</u>
- 5 the county commissioners shall be transmitted to the litter

- 28 violation of 75 Pa.C.S. § 3709 until six months after the
- 29 effective date of this section.
