- 12 WHEREAS, In 1984, President Ronald Reagan created "Military
- 13 Spouse Day" in recognition of the importance of spouse
- 14 commitment to the soldiers and military communities; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Military spouses often endure long separations from

- 2 care of their children and homes, as well as their careers; and
- 3 WHEREAS, As volunteers, military spouses have provided
- 4 exemplary service and leadership in educational, community,
- 5 recreational, religious, social and cultural endeavors; and
- 6 WHEREAS, On "Military Spouse Day" and throughout the year, we
- 7 honor the commitment military spouses make to their loved ones;
