A RESOLUTION

Commending the Pennsylvania Utility Contractors Association, 1 doing business as the National Ūtility Contractors 2 Association of Pennsylvania, and recognizing its 50th 3 anniversary as a trade association. 4 5 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Utility Contractors Association 6 (PUCA), doing business as the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) of Pennsylvania, is a 50-year-old nonprofit 7 8 trade association representing the underground utility construction industry; and 10 WHEREAS, PUCA's mission is to promote safe and responsible installation of new underground utility infrastructure and 11 12 rehabilitation of existing underground utility infrastructure, 13 including water, sewer, gas, electrical, telecommunications, water and wastewater treatment plants, dams and landfills; and 14 15 WHEREAS, PUCA brings the underground utility construction 16 industry, policymakers and stakeholders together as they focus

on long-range underground utility infrastructure development,

encouraging adequate government services, catalyzing consensus

on damage prevention issues and convening discussion relating to

- 1 safe and responsible installation; and
- 2 WHEREAS, PUCA is composed of a diverse membership of
- 3 recognized underground utility contractors, site developers,
- 4 engineers, heavy equipment dealers, equipment suppliers, law
- 5 firms, insurance bonding agents and anyone with an interest in
- 6 underground utility contracting in Pennsylvania; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The Western Pennsylvania Utility Contractors
- 8 Association (WPUCA) was incorporated on April 20, 1967, with 20
- 9 contractor members and 12 associate members; and
- 10 WHEREAS, WPUCA hosted the First Annual Convention of NUCA in
- 11 Pittsburgh on June 27 through 28, 1969; and
- 12 WHEREAS, WPUCA served the northwest, central and western
- 13 regions of Pennsylvania; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The Utility Contractors of Eastern Pennsylvania
- 15 (UCAEP) was incorporated on August 11, 1969, and was affiliated
- 16 with NUCA National in late 1969; and
- 17 WHEREAS, UCAEP served the northeast, capital and eastern
- 18 Pennsylvania regions; and
- 19 WHEREAS, In 1984, in recognition of common interests and
- 20 needs, the WPUCA and UCAEP were dissolved as corporations and
- 21 the new Statewide association was formed of stakeholders and
- 22 elected officials, administrators and professional staff
- 23 representing local government agencies along with State agencies
- 24 and legislative and executive leadership; and
- 25 WHEREAS, PUCA is committed to the mission of promoting safe
- 26 and responsible infrastructure installation and is proactively
- 27 involved in the formulation of policy and legislation critical
- 28 to the utility construction industry by addressing safety
- 29 issues, regulatory compliance and underground utility
- 30 infrastructure needs within this Commonwealth; and

- 1 WHEREAS, PUCA continues to increase its influence among
- 2 stakeholders, policymakers and elected officials Statewide; and
- 3 WHEREAS, PUCA is hosting its 50th anniversary celebration on
- 4 September 8 through 9, 2017, in State College to raise awareness
- 5 of the industry and the need for safety and to have its message
- 6 resonate among members of the subsurface utility industry and
- 7 the General Assembly; therefore be it
- 8 RESOLVED, That the Senate commend the Pennsylvania Utility
- 9 Contractors Association for its efforts to promote safe and
- 10 responsible installation of underground utilities in this
- 11 Commonwealth; and be it further
- 12 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the celebration on
- 13 September 8 through 9, 2017, marking the association's 50th
- 14 anniversary as a leading trade association; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate transmit a copy of
- 16 this resolution to the Pennsylvania Utility Contractors
- 17 Association.
