A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of November 2017 as "Home Care and Hospice Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Home care and hospice professionals provide an
- 4 essential service that many individuals with disabilities or
- 5 diseases rely on to live at home with their families and remain
- 6 a part of their communities; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Home care aides help with activities of daily living
- 8 such as remembering to take medications, preparing meals,
- 9 transferring from a chair, toilet or bed, bathing, dressing,
- 10 light housekeeping and transportation to and from doctor's
- 11 appointments; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Hospice end-of-life care brings together medical
- 13 care, pain management and emotional and spiritual support for
- 14 terminal patients and their families; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Home health agencies provide skilled services, which
- 16 include nursing care and physical, occupational, speech and
- 17 respiratory therapy; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Home care and hospice professionals work side by
- 2 side with patients' families involved in the patients' care and
- 3 take time to teach the proper techniques; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Home care and hospice professionals in this
- 5 Commonwealth provide care to nearly 1 million consumers a year,
- 6 the equivalent of 100 consumers every hour; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Personal care aide and home health aide jobs are
- 8 projected to grow by 70% in the next seven years, the largest
- 9 employment growth among all occupations in the United States, in
- 10 response to this Commonwealth's population being the fourth
- 11 oldest in the nation; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Hospices in this Commonwealth provide better quality
- 13 care than the national average, with Pennsylvania having an
- 14 overall average score of 93.8% compared to the national average
- 15 score of 92.6%; therefore be it
- 16 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of November
- 17 2017 as "Home Care and Hospice Month" in Pennsylvania to
- 18 recognize and show appreciation for the dedication and
- 19 contributions of home care and hospice providers to enhancing
- 20 the lives of their patients.
